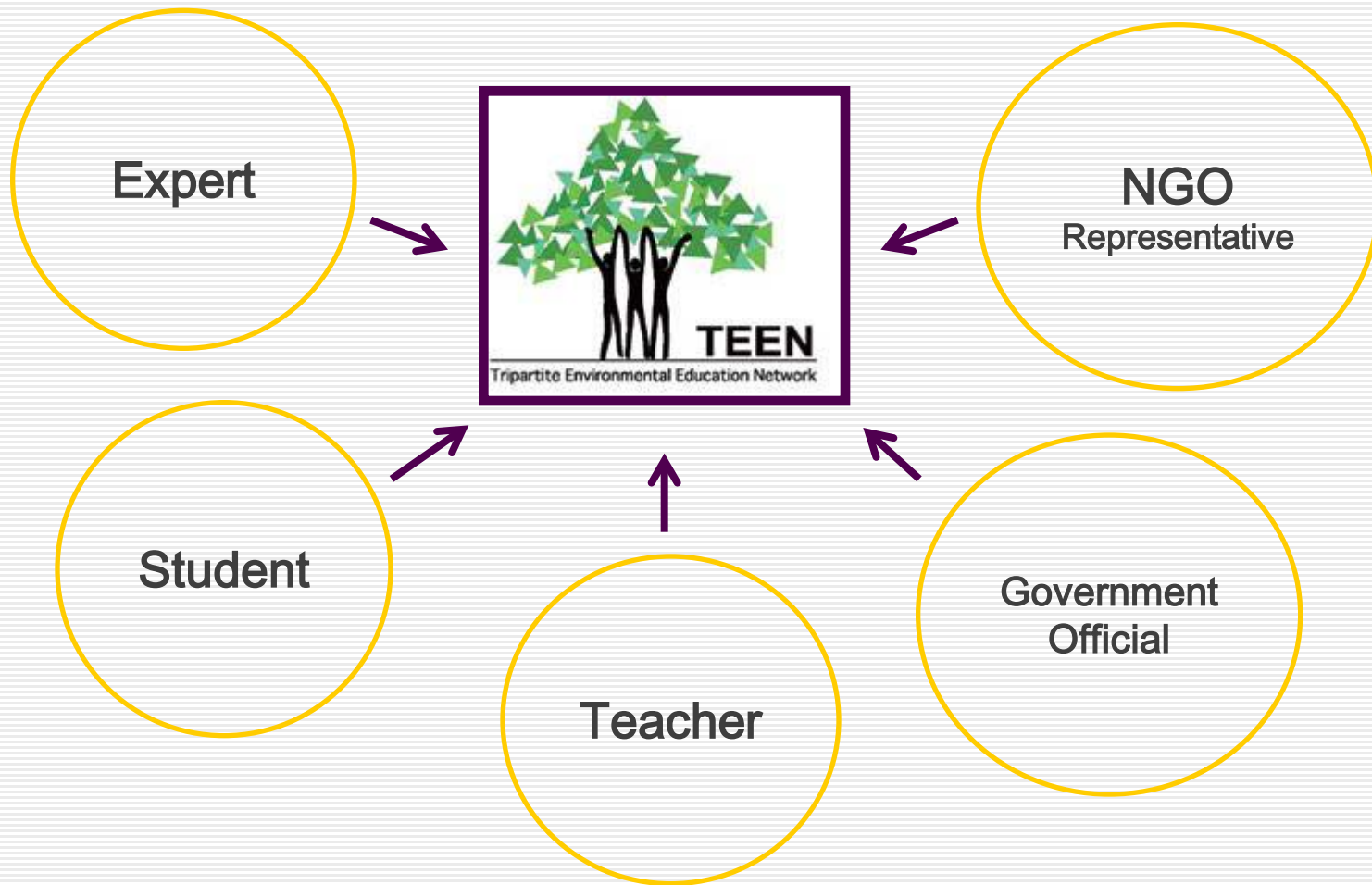

- Need guideline for w/s, annual report

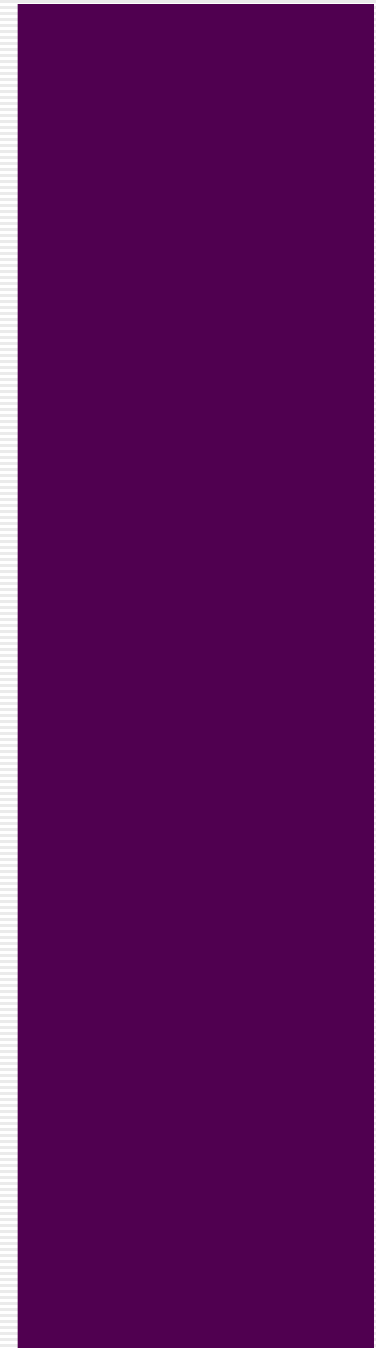

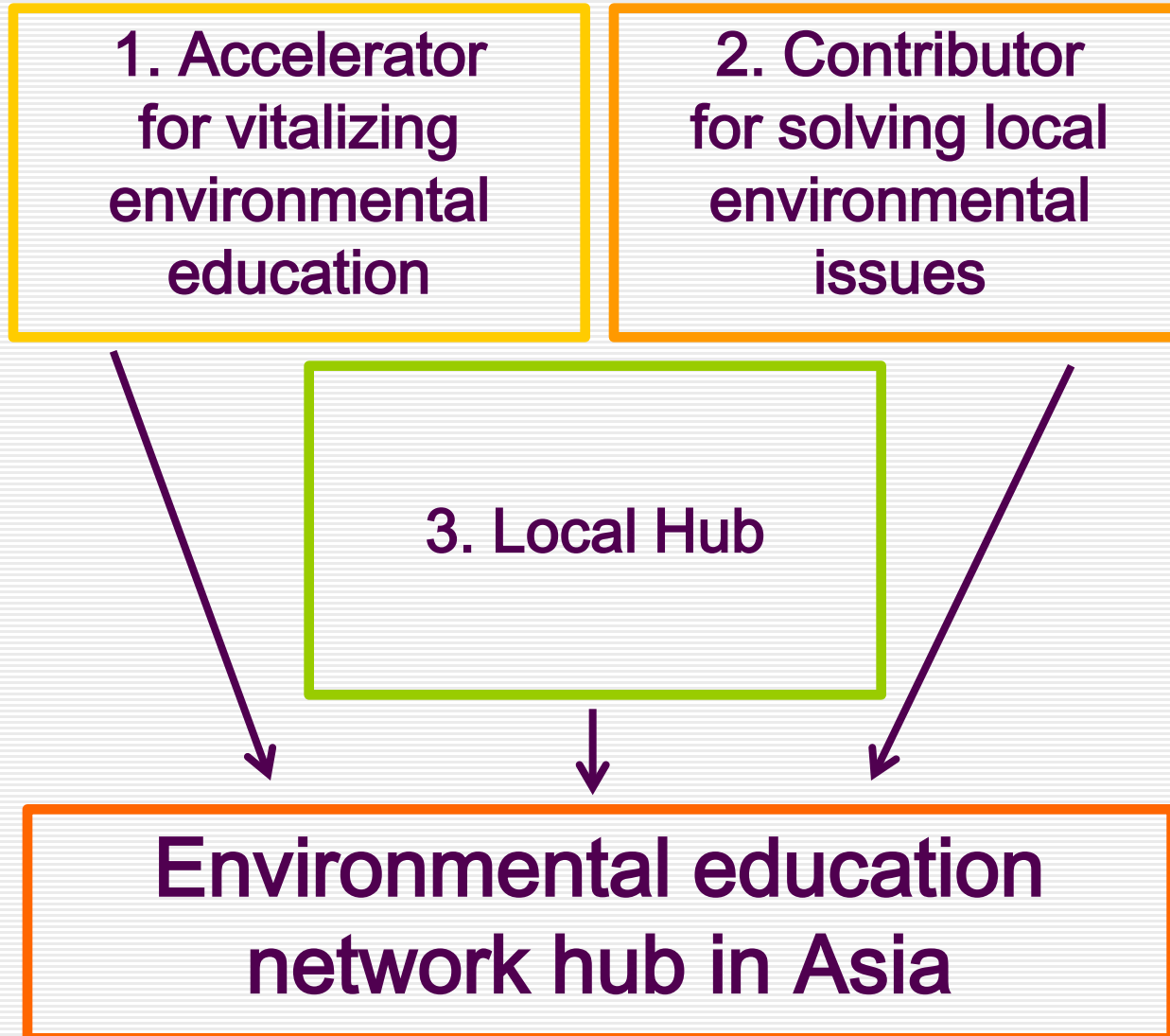

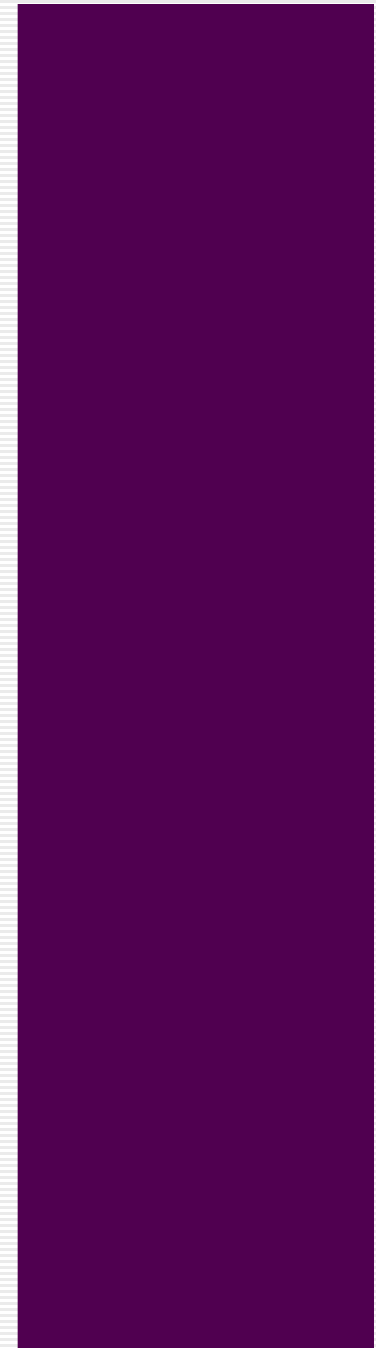
