Schedule for the Minamata Visit Full-Day Programme on 9 October 2013

- On Wednesday, 9 October 2013, the Government of Japan will organize a one-day 'Minamata Visit' programme, during which participants are able to visit Minamata city, the site of the Minamata Disease outbreak caused by contamination from methyl mercury-containing effluent from chemical plants that occurred more than fifty years ago.
- Among the many events, a "remembrance" and a "floral tribute" are planned at the Cenotaph for Minamata Disease Victims in Eco-Park in Minamata city. Also, there will be an opportunity to learn the history and lessons of Minamata Disease and current activities for revitalization of Minamata through a visit to the Minamata Disease Archive, Municipal Museum, and Prefectural Environmental Center.
- In the evening of 9 October, a Ceremonial Opening of the Diplomatic Conference will be held, where a "Lecture by storyteller" will be performed. A reception hosted by Japan will follow the Ceremonial Opening.
- For the full day programme, in addition to the above, participants can visit a small-scale care facility to dialogue with patients or a private museum to learn more about the history of Minamata Disease.

Note	-The display of conference badges is mandatory to gain access to the venues in Minamata city. Participants are requested to register and receive their


