Purpose	- To protect human health and the environment from mercury (§ 1)
Supply and trade	- Not allow primary mercury mining (§ 3) - Provide written consent in export and import (§ 3)
Mercury-added products & processes	- Not allow the manufacture, import and export of mercury-added products listed in Annex A (§ 4) - Not allow the use of mercury in manufacturing processes (§ 5)
ASGM	- To reduce and eliminate the use of mercury in ASGM (§ 7)
Emissions and Releases	- Control and reduce emissions releases of mercury (§ 8, § 9) - BAT/BEP for new sources, take measures for existing sources
Storage, wastes and contaminated sites	- Guideline/guidance on environmentally sound management (§ 10 - § 12)
Financial mechanism & technical assistance	- GEF/ Special international Programme (§ 13) - capacity-building, technical assistance, technology transfer (§ 14)

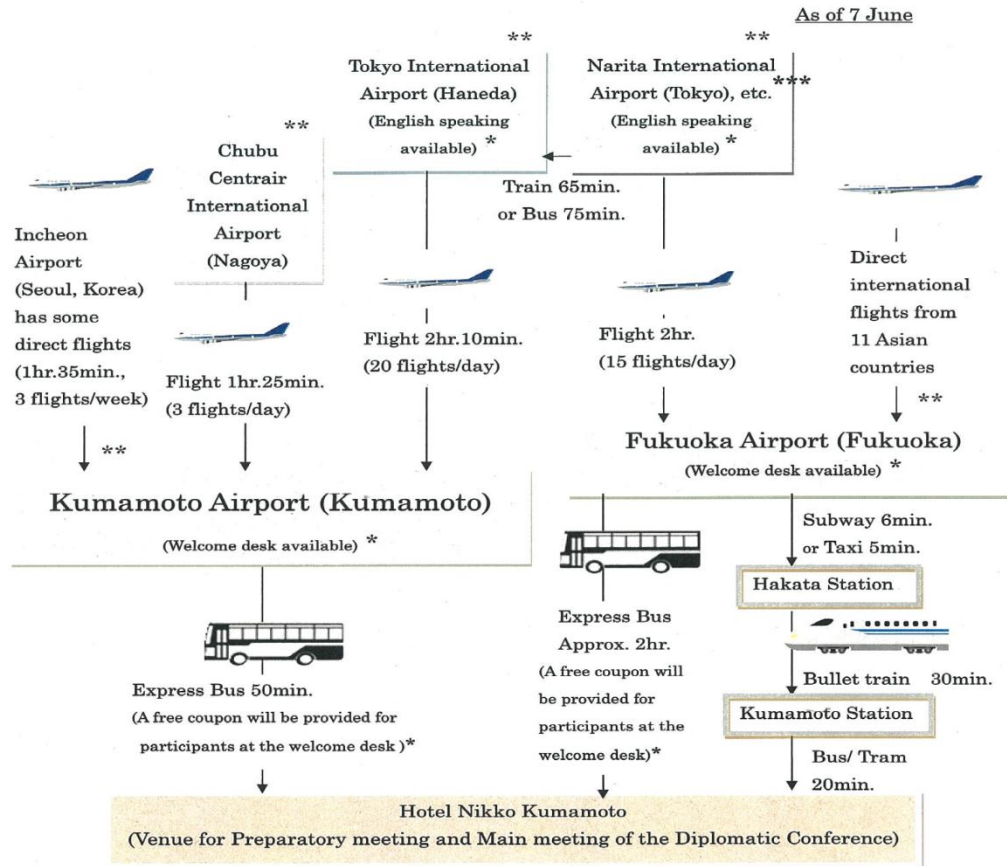

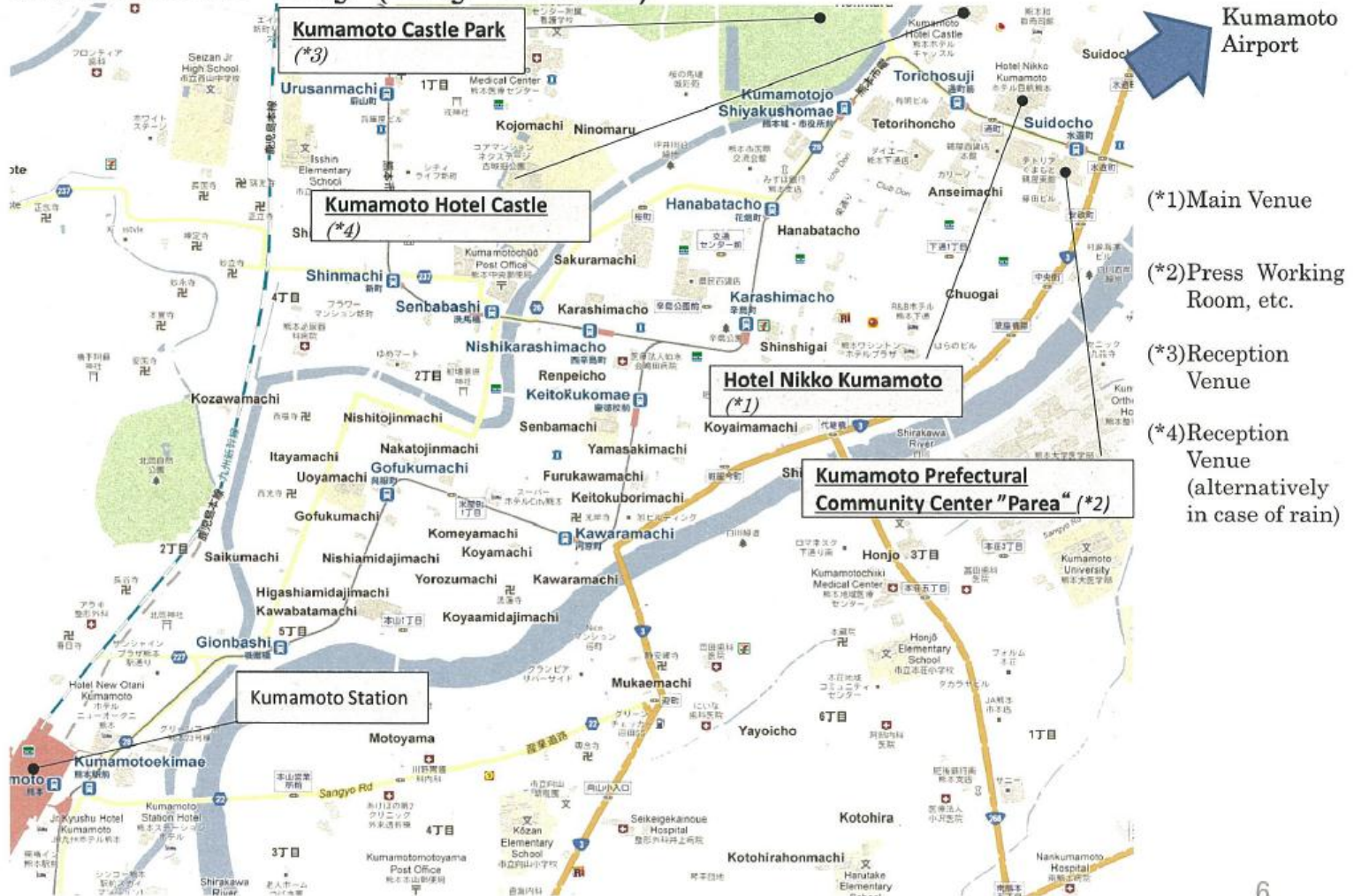

In order to prevent global environmental pollution and health damage caused by mercury, a new convention named "Minamata Convention on Mercury" was agreed at the fifth session of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee to prepare a global legally binding instrument on mercury (INC5) held in Geneva, Switzerland in January 2013. The Convention will be adopted and open for signature at the Conference of Plenipotentiaries (Diplomatic Conference) to be held in October in Japan.

Learning the history of and lessons from Minamata Disease

"Minamata Disease", a serious health damage and environmental destruction, was caused by improper management of mercury and delayed appropriate measures. Ministry of the Environment of Japan published a booklet "Lessons from Minamata Disease and Mercury Management in Japan" to share the lessons learned from Minamata Disease and the knowledge on mercury management in Japan with other countries. Six UN languages versions are now available.

Diplomatic Conference for the Minamata Convention on Mercury

The Conference of Plenipotentiaries on the "Minamata Convention on Mercury" will be held in Minamata and Kumamoto, Japan, from 9 to 11 October 2013 and will be preceded by an open-ended intergovernmental preparatory meeting from 7 to 8 October 2013.

At the fifth session of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee to prepare a global legally binding instrument on mercury, held in Geneva from 13 to 18 January 2013, Governments successfully completed their negotiations. They agreed to the text of the "Minamata Convention on Mercury", which will be opened for signature at the Conference of Plenipotentiaries - Diplomatic Conference - scheduled to take place at hotel Nikko in Kumamoto and in Minamata, Japan, from 9 to 11 October 2013.

The Diplomatic Conference will be preceded by an open-ended intergovernmental preparatory meeting to be held on 7 and 8 October 2013 in Kumamoto.

Invitation letters will be sent to Governments as well as Intergovernmental Organizations and non-governmental organizations.

The alternate language versions of the draft Minamata Convention on Mercury are now available here. The final language versions of the Convention text will be posted as soon as finalized.

Governments are reminded that in order for their representatives to sign the Minamata Convention on Mercury during the Diplomatic Conference, if not represented by the Head of State or Government or the Minister for Foreign Affairs in person, the representatives must be accorded full powers. More information on credentials and full powers will be provided later.

Non-governmental organizations are reminded of the need for accreditation to participate in the Conference of Plenipotentiaries as an observer.

CIQ and visa

1. CIQ

(1) General issues

Each country/institution is responsible of CIQ clearance in airports. No MOE and MOFA officer in the airport. For further information, each country/institution should contact airport officers.

(2) Fingerprint exemption

Regardless of visa exemption agreement for diplomatic, official and ordinary passport, some governments/institutions need to provide Japanese embassies with necessary information including flight information for fingerprint exemption.

2. Visa

Unless visa exemption agreements are effective with Japan, participants are responsible for obtaining a visa for entering Japan.

CIQ (Customs officers in airports)

1. Contact customs officers to enter the restricted area to pick up international flight passengers. NOT allowed to enter the restricted area to pick up domestic flight passengers.
