
Role of UNEP

- Provide guidance on relating the GEF-financed activities to global, regional and national environmental assessments, policy frameworks and plans and to international environmental agreements.
- Responsible for establishing and supporting the Scientific and Technical Advisory Panel (STAP) as an advisory body to GEF.
