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Main CDM Activities and Arrangement for CNA in Vietnam

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Background Information

- Vietnam signed the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) on 11 June 1992, ratified it on 16 November 1994.
- Kyoto Protocol (KP): signed on 3 December 1998 and ratified on 25 September 2002.
- The Hydro-Meteorological Service of Viet Nam, nowadays Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (MONRE) is assigned by the Government as a National Authority for implementing UNFCCC and KP.



Background Information (Cont.)

- Viet Nam is carrying out a National Strategy Study on CDM project (NSS) supported by the Government of Australia through World Bank (WB).
- National Steering Committee and Study Team of NSS have been established.
- Country GHG emission reduction potential and costs are assessed.
- Climate change potential projects are identified and developed.
- UNEP Project: "Capacity Development for CDM" has being carried out in Viet Nam since 2002



Main CDM Activities

- Researching the GHG Abatement Potential of Vietnam
 (Focusing on research of abatement potential in Energy Sector)
- Evaluating Vietnam's Supply Potential
- Studying CDM Market Opportunities for Vietnam
- Realizing CDM Opportunity for Vietnam
- Developing Portfolio of CDM Projects
- Carrying out Capacity Development for the CDM
 (Focusing on policymakers and business circle)



To meet one of three basic requirement:

- Establishment of a CDM National Authority (CNA)
- Ratification of the KP
- Voluntary participation in the CDM



Point of view on CNA

- * Based on existing organizations with neatly arrangement
- * Process quickly work related to CDM but keep within the existing law
- * Obtain maximum possible benefit from participation in the CDM market
- * Accord with Kyoto Protocol and domestic circumstance
- * Capacity development for the CNA to manage CDM activities plays an important role in CDM implementation in the country




- Functions of CNA:
 - ✓ Building national criteria and guidelines on CDM
 - ✓ Assess CDM projects at the national level
 - ✓ Submit CDM projects to National Executive Board (NEB) and manage them
 - ✓ Propose approved CDM project to Executive Board by issuing a formal letter of approval
 - Co-ordination with relation international organizations in CDM activities
- CNA is responsible for identification, assessment, validation, implementation, monitoring, verification and certification of CDM project



- As required by Marrakech Accords, when approving CDM projects, CNA should:
 - ✓ Confirm that participation is voluntary
 - ✓ Confirm that the project assists the host country in achieving sustainable development
 - ✓ Authorize private/public entities to participate in CDM activities.

Establishment and Capacity Development for CNA

- Main, important task under UNEP Project: CD4CDM in the period 2003-2005.
- Task outputs:
 - 1. Establishment of a CDM National Authority (2003)
 - 2. Drafting rule and regulation for CNA functioning to manage the development, validation, implementation, monitoring, verification and certification of CDM project activities (2003-2004)
 - 3. Effective CNA operation in CDM activity management in projects validation, approval, monitoring, verification and certification and in international cooperation (2004-2005)
 - 4. Enhancement of regulatory framework to promote CDM projects (2005)



Vietnam CDM Project Cycle

- Project design: design and feasibility study of project should be carried out by Project Proponents (PP) including foreign partners
- Validation: project design must be validated independently by an internationally accredited Operational Entity (OE)
- Host country approval: Analysis and endorsement by CNA. (It is MONRE)
- Registration: Sign up the CDM project with the CDM Executive Board (EB)




Vietnam CDM Project Cycle

- Monitoring: implementation and monitoring of CDM projects will be carried out by Project Partners or accredited Operational Entities
- Verification: CDM project performance should be assessed independently by accredited Operational Entities
- Certification: Written assurance of the performance of CDM projects should be given by accredited Operational Entities
- Issuance: After agreement by the CNA, CDM project credits should be approved and registered by CDM Executive Board accredited by COP

 - ✓ Reforming existing structure to involve relevant ministries in CDM management.
 - ✓ Integrating CDM issues into development strategies, policies, plans of main sectors.
 - ✓ Setting up legal basic for CDM activities in Viet Nam.
 - ✓ Developing criteria for CDM project assessment in a view of SD
 - ✓ Formulating rule and regulation agreement with related project partners





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
