



### CDM/JI Acceleration Programme (2004)

- Fifteen host countries in Asia, Central and South America, and CIS/East Europe.
  - China, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines,
     Thailand, Vietnam,
  - ◆Brazil, Chile, Mexico,
  - Bulgaria, Czech, Poland, Romania, and Ukraine





#### Major outputs and findings

- Discussion with DNA, major private sectors in host countries, and Japanese private entities in those host countries.
- Capacity building in accordance with the needs of each host country, and collect information of most potential CDM/JI project.
- 96 project information, including 80 PINs (project idea note) were collected from 11 countries.

- Awareness/incentives for private entities in host countries.



#### FAQ from Japanese companies

## ■ Concerning the host country:

- What will be the most frequent barrier to realize a CDM project in a certain country?
- Which host country will be most friendly or have easy access system?
- What will be the critical issues for the negotiation with host country's DNA?
- ◆What will be the merit and demerit to implement a CDM project in certain country/field?



# ■ Concerning the project:

FAQ from Japanese companies

- How can we collect data and information essential for the baseline setting and monitoring?
- How long will it take for the host country's approval?
- How long will it take for the EB's approval?
- How much will be the CER from our project?

## What will help the realization of CDM projects?

- Basic information for private entities in both sides, concerning issues in FAQ,
- One stop shop to help access to data and information, including PIN,
- Business matching scheme for most probable and/or priority projects,
- Promote diversity of project types (e.g., energy efficiency, transport, etc.), and
- Develop incentives or support scheme to promote adaptation-related CDM projects.
