# Climate Change Issue in the AP context

- Asia-Pacific Region
  - Geographically wide and economically, socially, culturally diverse
  - Rapid Increase of GHG, and highly vulnerable to climate change
  - **Most countries are developing countries** → For many countries, “development” is not a negligible aspect of climate change issue

## □ “Good Governance”

= Long debated term.....

But, to avoid unnecessary complications, the APS tentatively suggests the term to be used as a **“process, arrangement, and tools and methods, that enable us to address climate change and development concerns in harmonized way.**

## □ **Inductive discussion** (not deductive)

= our discussion should be always based on practical view points, rather than concept/principle-oriented ones.
