Support to countries to prepare for negotiations, by jointly studying technical aspects of issues.

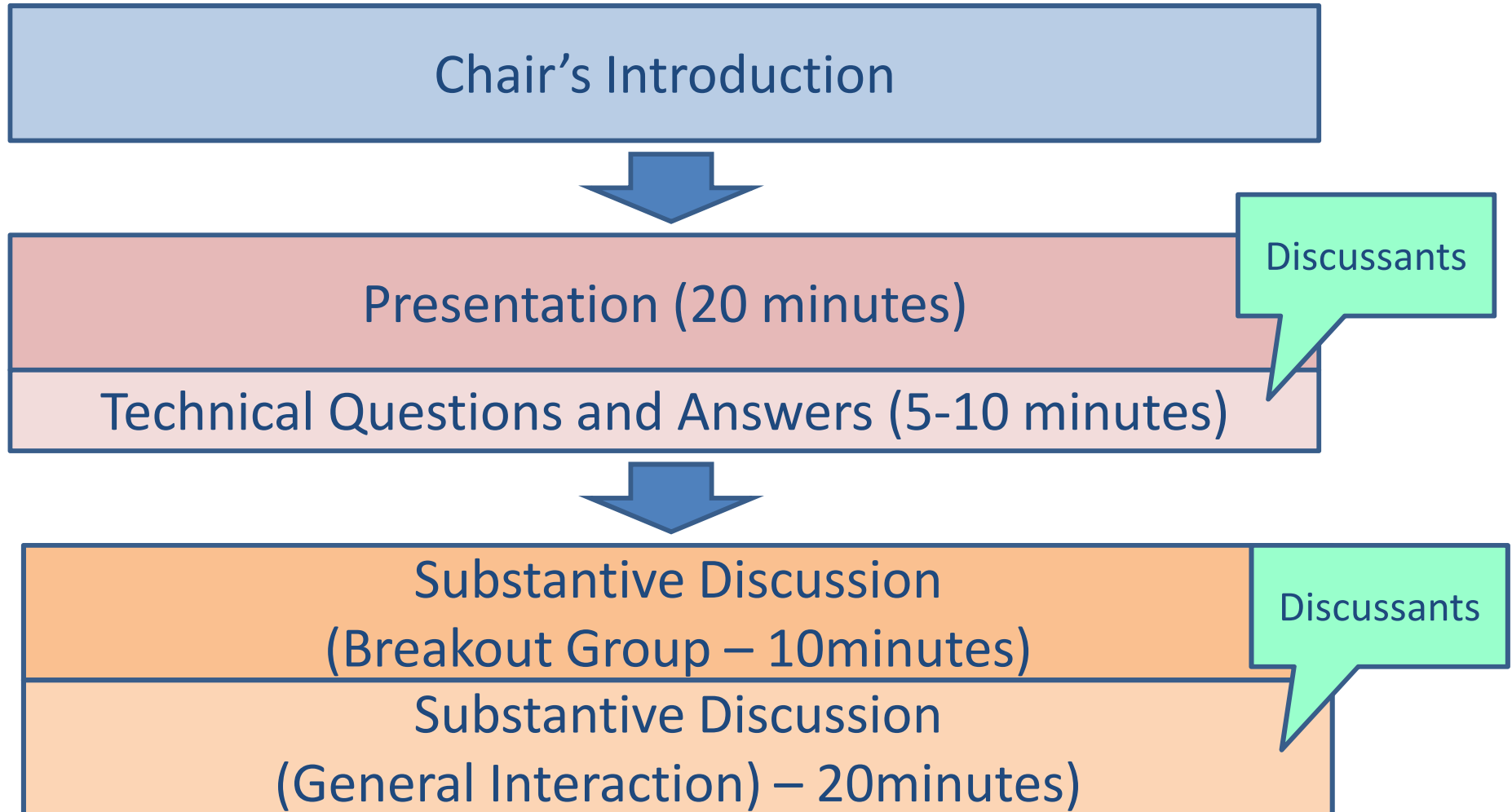
Stock-take and strengthen region's current efforts to address climate change and give feedbacks to/from climate change administrators

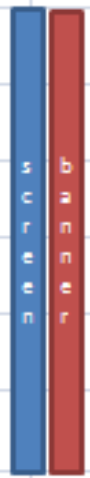
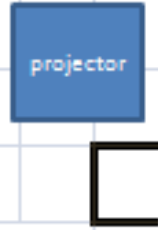
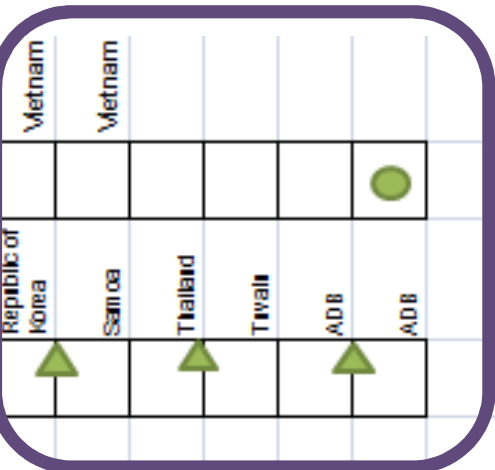
Proceedings of the Substantive Sessions (Basic Structure)

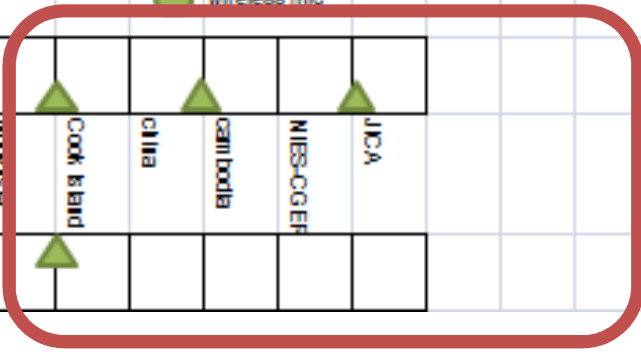
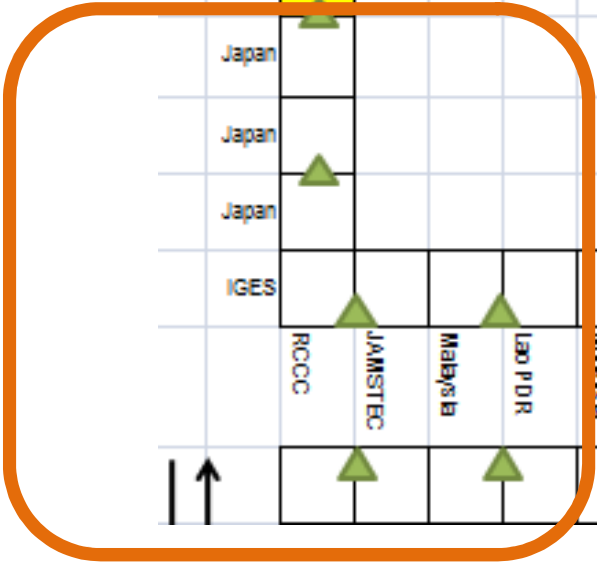
