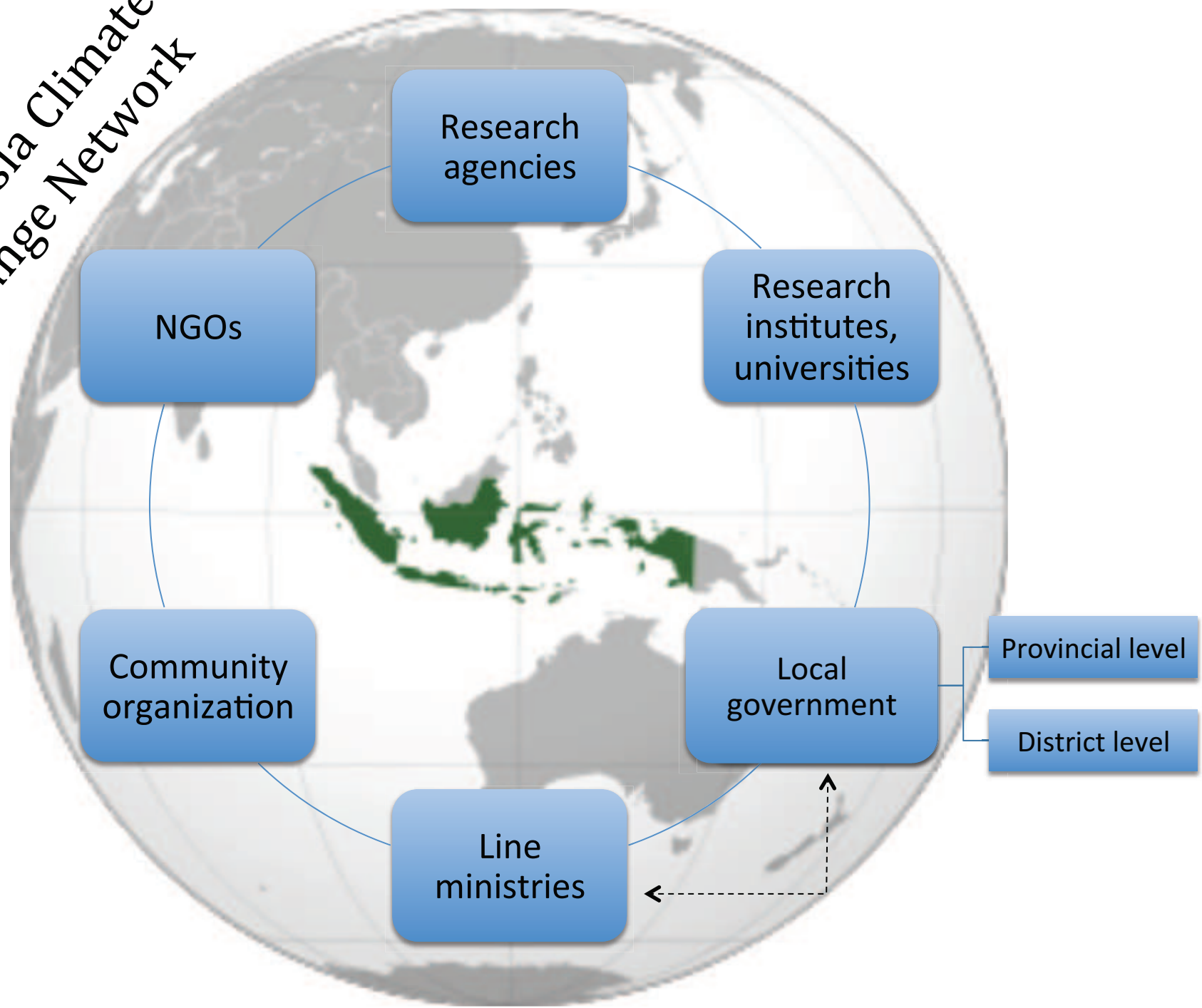

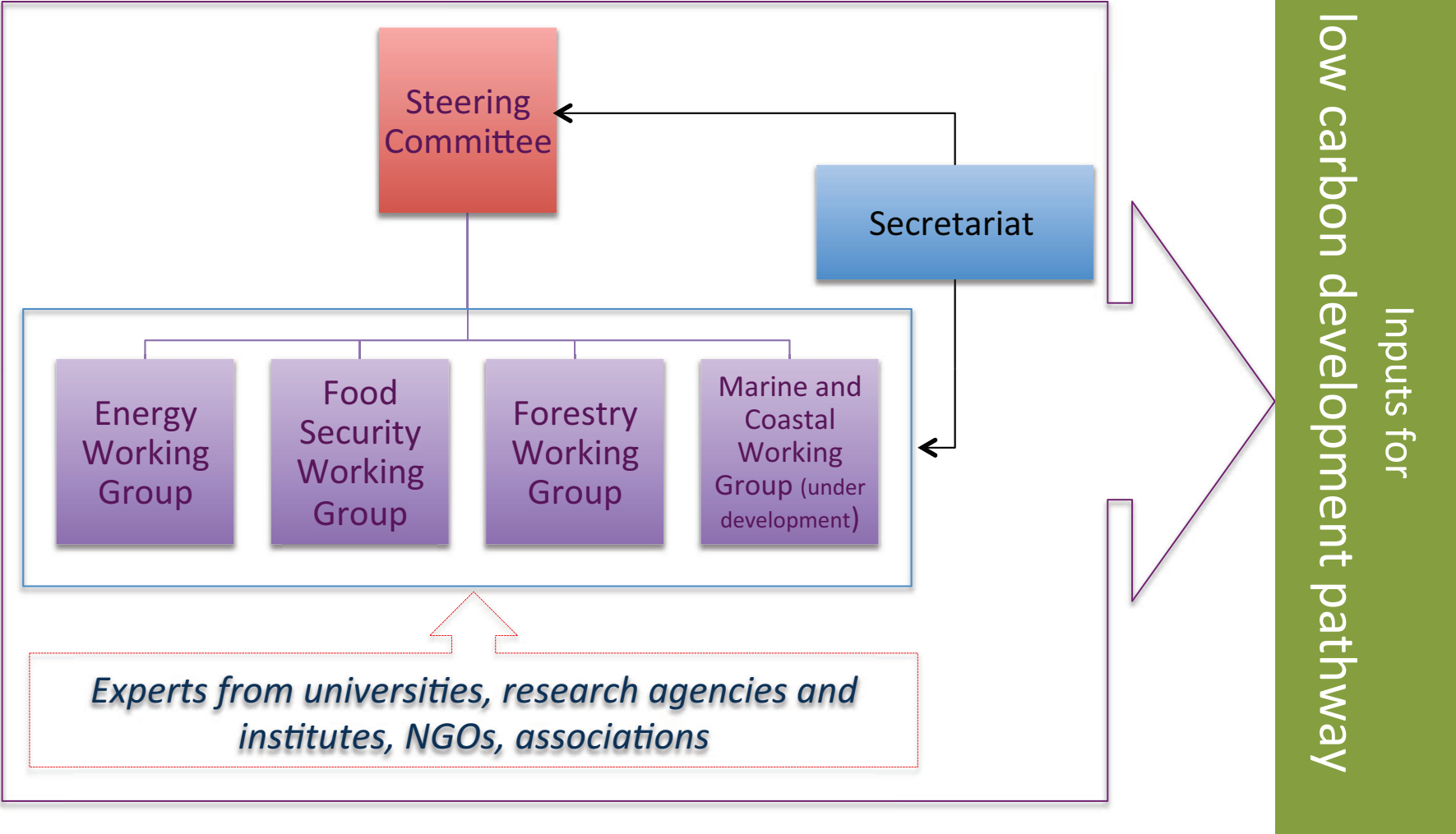

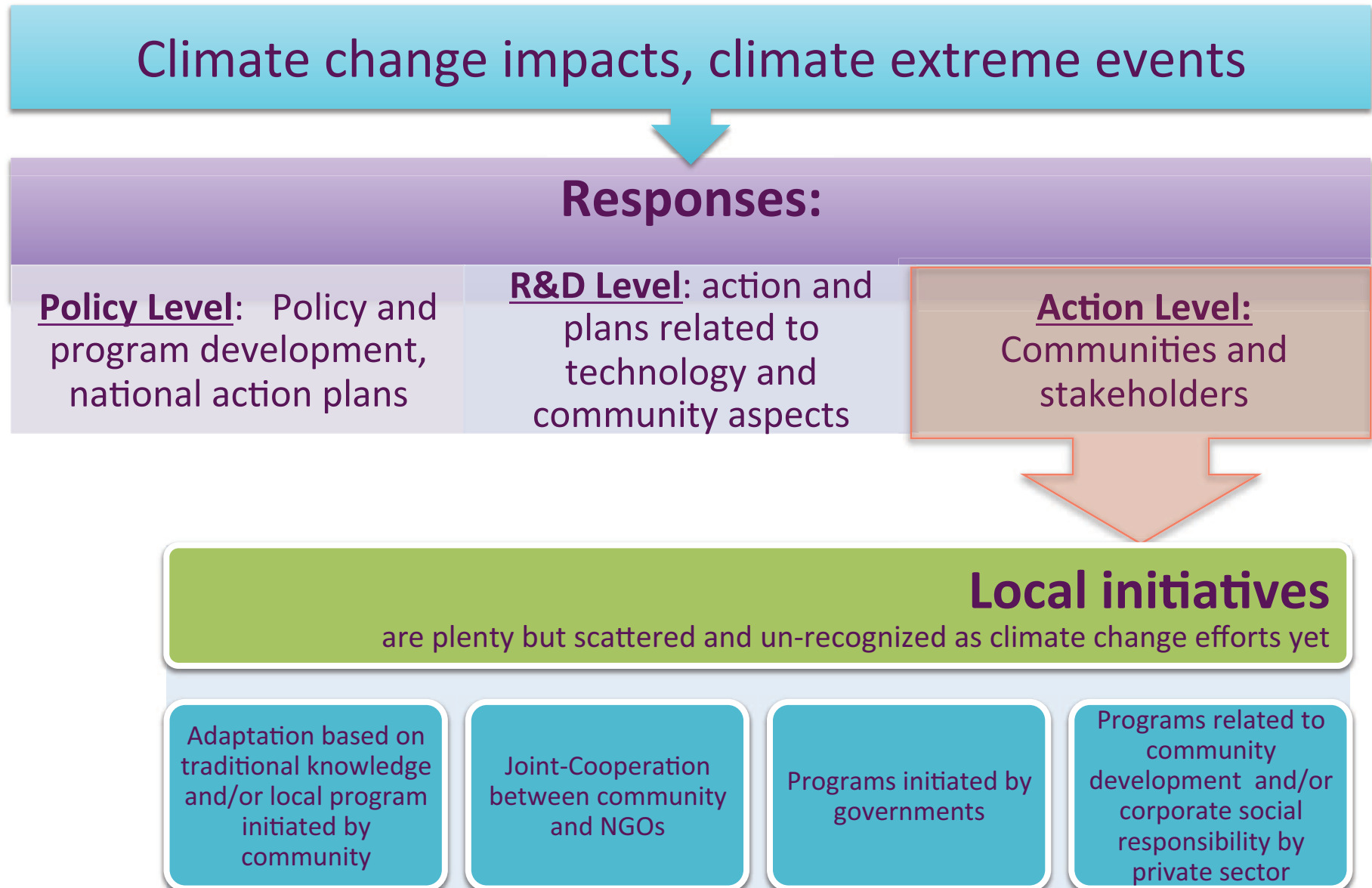
Indonesia Climate Change Network



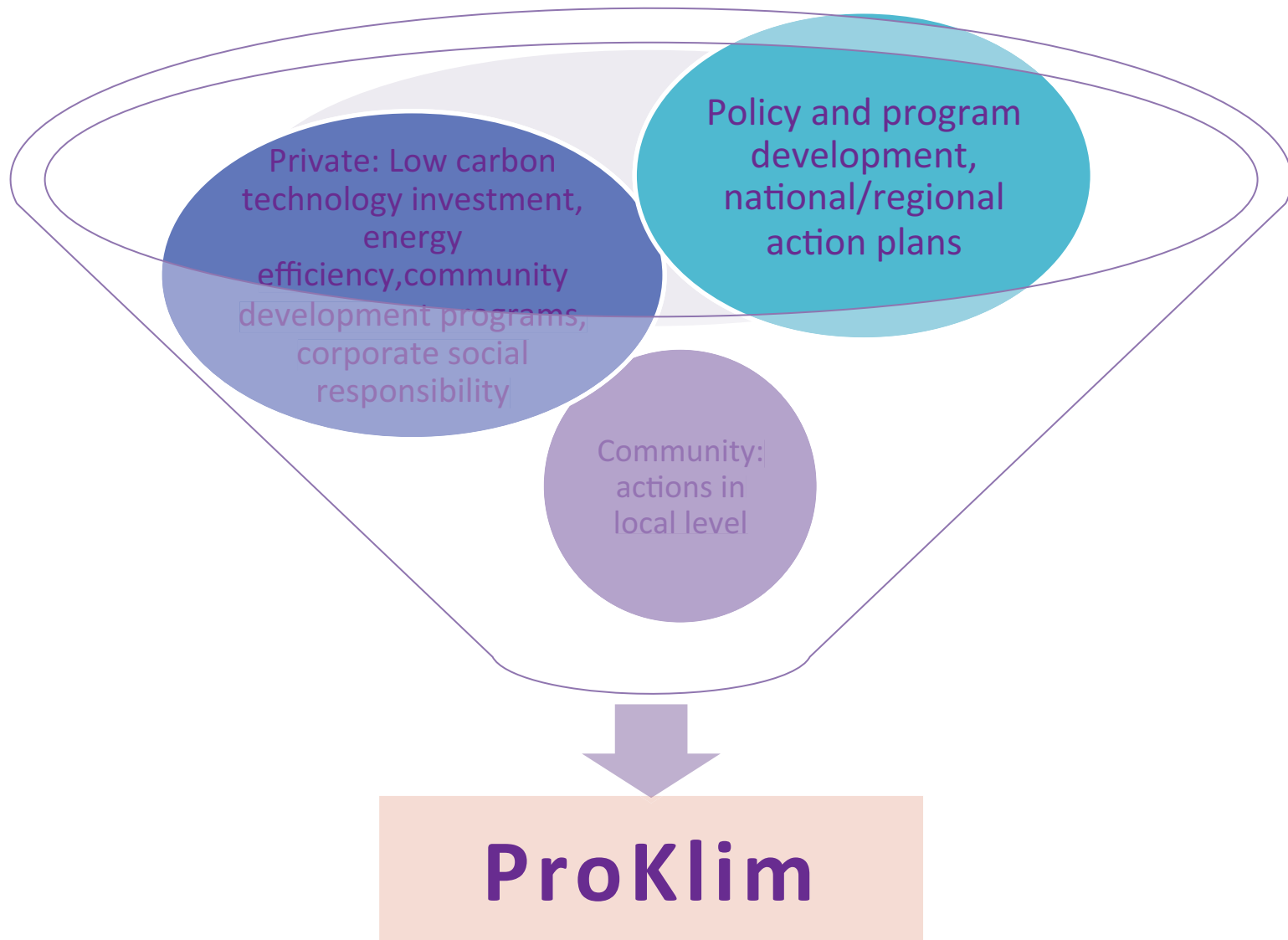
Indonesia Panel on Climate Change

Climate change adaptation and mitigation in local level

Program Kampung Iklim (ProKlim)

-Climate Village Program-

- “Kampung” in Indonesian or “Village” in plain English → is administered according to traditions and customary law (adat), located in rural areas and urban subdivisions, practices the culture of helping one another as a community, as well as being family-oriented, courtesy and believing in God as paramount to everything else.
- Various name of “kampung” in Indonesia: *banjar* (Bali), *nagari* (West Sumatera), *dusun* (Java), etc

ProKlim

- is a program to recognize active participation of local communities in implementing climate change mitigation and adaptation actions, which contributes to the achievement of national green house gas reduction target and increases the community resilience to the climate change impact.
