Adaptation Practice: Working with NGOs at the community level, the project aims to (1) help communities better understand sources of their vulnerability; (2) help them establish a community-level action plan based on vulnerability assessments and localized climate change projections; (3) finance such plans through project grants and public development funds; and (4) identify effective measures to be integrated into provincial development plans and sector policies.

Increasing Resilience of Coastal Areas and Communities to Climate Change in Tuvalu

Location: Tuvalu

Adaptation Issue: Small island communities at risk from sea-level rise, coastal erosion and cyclones

Adaptation Practice: With a primary focus of enhancing the resilience of vulnerable communities the project operates: (1) nationally, by developing the capacity of officials in integrating climate risks into national development and key sectoral policies such as water, public works and agriculture; (2) at island level by integrating climate 'considerations' into Island Development Plans; (3) at community level by implementing community-based adaptation measures.

Piloting Climate Change Adaptation to Protect Human Health

Location: China, as part of a global project on public health adaptation to climate change

Adaptation Issue: Existing health infra is not equipped to address emerging climate-induced health risks

Adaptation Practice: (1) Establish early warning systems that link climate monitoring and national health systems to effectively respond to climate-induced health risks; (2) Build the capacity of the health sector for developing coordination mechanism and operational procedures for meteorological and health sectors during heatwaves; (3) identify and share best practices to address the health risks associated with climate change across the region.
