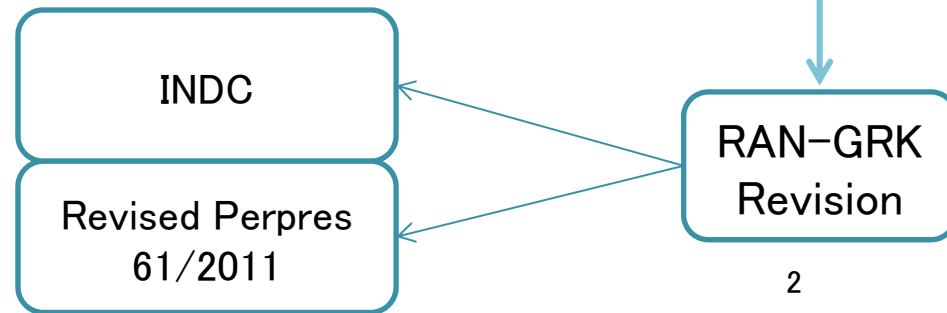
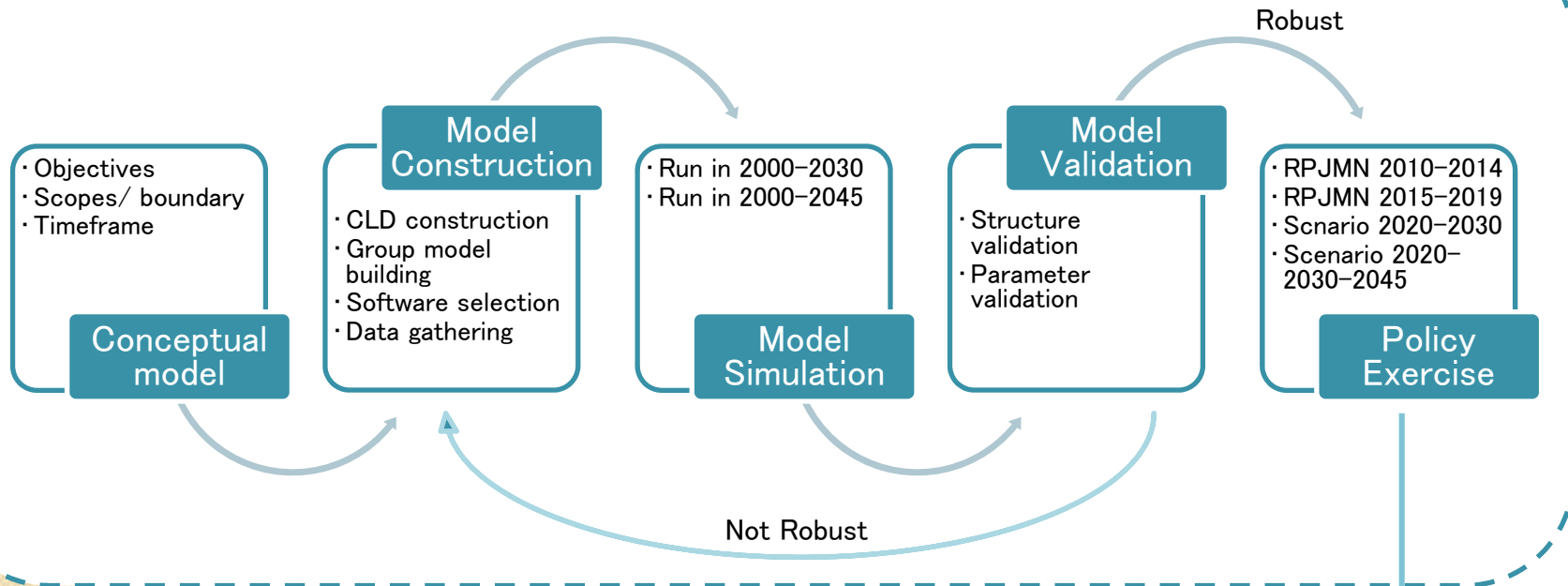

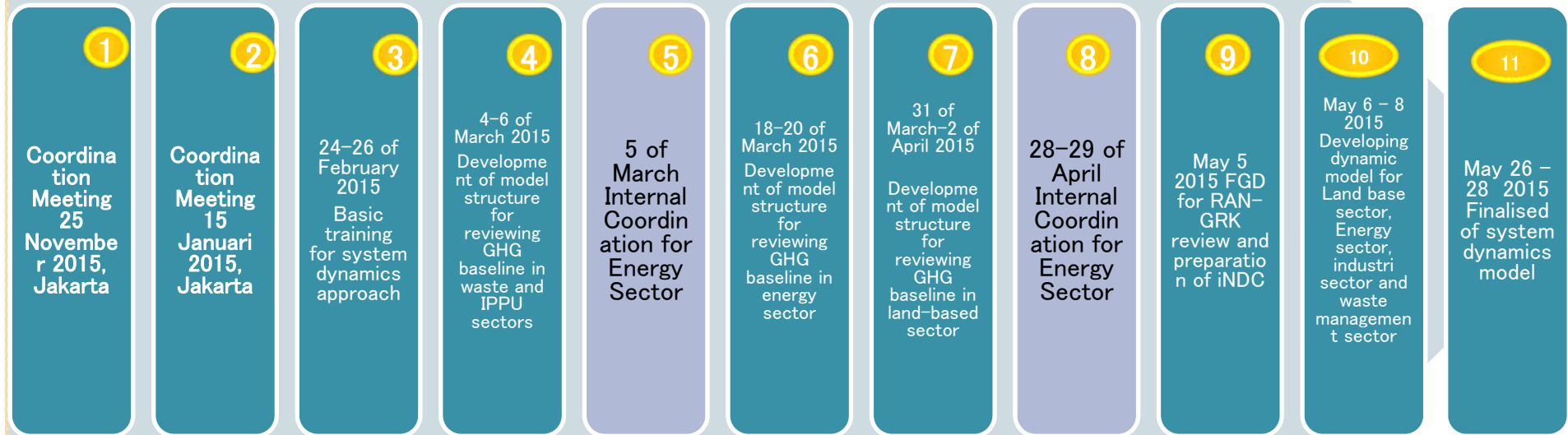


Principles of Engagement in INDC process:

- Developing common need to review the RAN-GRK baseline and policies for each sector.
- Establishing a dedicated team for INDC recommended by the decision makers of the line agencies.
- Transparent process between line ministries.
- Creating dialogues through model development and policy scenarios.
- Knowledge development through a series of trainings and focus group discussions.
- Involvement of decision makers in a few of important milestones.

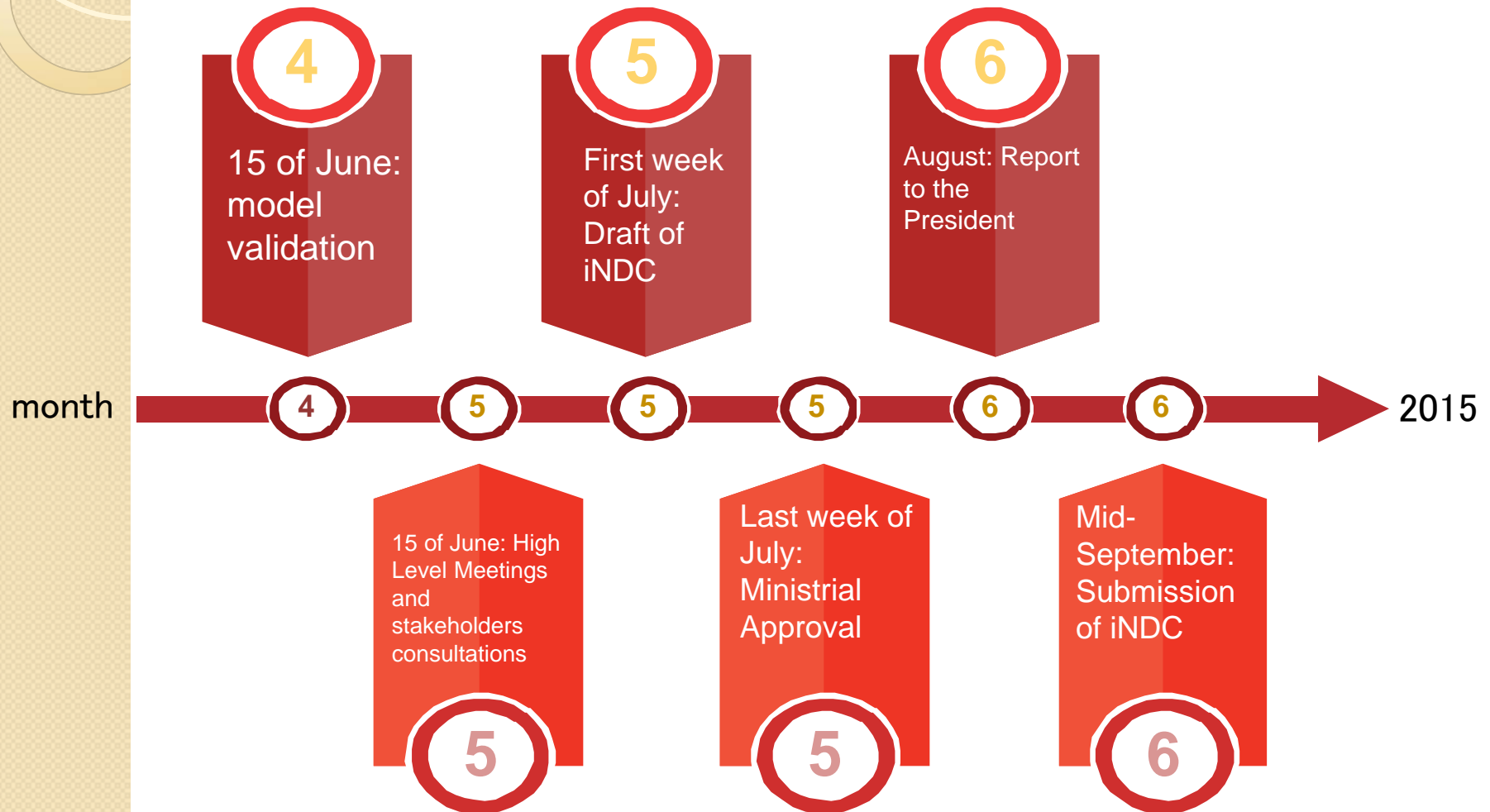
