Paris Agreement: Article 7.9

9. Each Party shall, as appropriate, <u>engage in adaptation planning processes</u> and the implementation of actions, including the development or enhancement of relevant plans, policies and/or contributions, which may include:


(a) The implementation of adaptation actions, undertakings and/or efforts;
(b) <u>The process to formulate and implement national adaptation plans</u>;



Paris Agreement: Article 7.10

10. Each Party should, as appropriate, submit and update periodically an adaptation communication, which may include its priorities, implementation and support needs, plans and actions, without creating any additional burden for developing country Parties.



Paris Agreement: Article 7.11

11. The <u>adaptation communication</u> referred to in paragraph 10 of this Article shall be, as appropriate, submitted and updated periodically, **as a component of or in conjunction with other communications or documents**, including <u>a national adaptation plan</u>, <u>a nationally determined</u> <u>contribution</u> as referred to in Article 4, paragraph 2, and/or <u>a national</u> <u>communication</u>.
