

Relevant local social and cultural context:

Savu Sea MPA

Heterogeneous and relatively expose to outsiders (better accessibility).

Local values and traditions are practiced only in some part of the areas / communities

Traditional (property) rights over islands and body of waters are no longer exercised

Local fishing practices have been for commercials and a small bit of subsistence

Raja Ampat MPA network

Homogenous and relatively still less expose to outsiders up until recently (limited accessibility)

Local values and traditions are relatively practiced in all communities in the area

Traditional (property) rights over islands and body of waters are exercised and respected

Local fishing practices are relatively mostly for subsistence

Funding source: national budget	Funding source: district budget and visitor entrance fees






