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

 - Amended in 1994, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2001
 - Waste Management Act
- Focal Point : Ministry of Environment (MoE)
- Competent Authorities
 - MoE Regional Offices (8)

Definition of hazardous waste

- MoE Public Notice 1998-78: For TBM control
 - Annex VIII (The Basel Convention)
 - Red & Amber Tier wastes (OECD)
 - ❖ Annex IX (The Basel Convention)
- Waste Management Act
 - Designated waste : For domestic control
 - Amount of designated waste generated :2,915,000 ton (2002)



National strategies

- Reduction of waste generation at source
- Promotion of domestic recycling of industrial wastes
- Safe treatment and disposal
- Minimization of TBM

Restrictions on TBM

- No TBM w/o prior written consents
- MoE may limit or ban TBM of specific wastes
- No restriction on the country or regions for TBM

Challenges for successful implementation of BC

- (1) High demand for recycled materials in Asian region
 - Specialized economic structure
 - Different stage in economic development
 - Gaps in waste treatment cost
 - Different demand for recycled materials
 - Fast growing market
- (2) No systematic assessment for hazardous characteristics
 - Difficulty in differentiating the Annex VIII and the Annex IX wastes

(3) Weakness in Compliance Monitoring system

- Surveillance during Customs Clearance
 - Less than 5% exporting commodities checked
- Divided role between local governments and MoE

(4) Waste ??

- Debatable definition
 - Grey area between wastes and second-hand commodity
- Falsehood in HS code recording

(5) Insufficient public awareness



- Enhancing Infrastructure for BC implementation
 - Integrated management on the designated wastes and Annex VIII wastes
 - Changing competent authorities
 - Assessing "Hazardous Characteristics"
- Strengthening inter-governmental cooperation
 - Customs Offices
 - Local governments
 - Regional Offices of MoE
- Raising public awareness
 - Improving supportive system for exporters/importers
 - web-site & pamphlet
 - Establishment of e-learning system
