Duties of Competent Authority

- 1. Inform to the secretariat about the Convention of the wastes, other than those listed in Annexes I and II**
- 2. Inform to the secretariat about any significant changes to the information**



Duties of Competent Authority

- 3. Inform all parties of the information it has received**
- 4. Prohibit the importation of hazardous wastes for disposal**



Duties of Competent Authority

5. Allow the importation of hazardous wastes for disposal if the state of import does consent

1. Quantity Permission of Exported Hazardous Wastes *about 9,141.7 tons*
2. Total Company Permission of Exported Hazardous Wastes *about 19 companies*
