- Organization of interministerial ad-hoc agency to control the illegal trafficking -> internal reporting system
- Enforces the BC form for notification into domestic law (Circular 12/2007/TT-BTNMT)

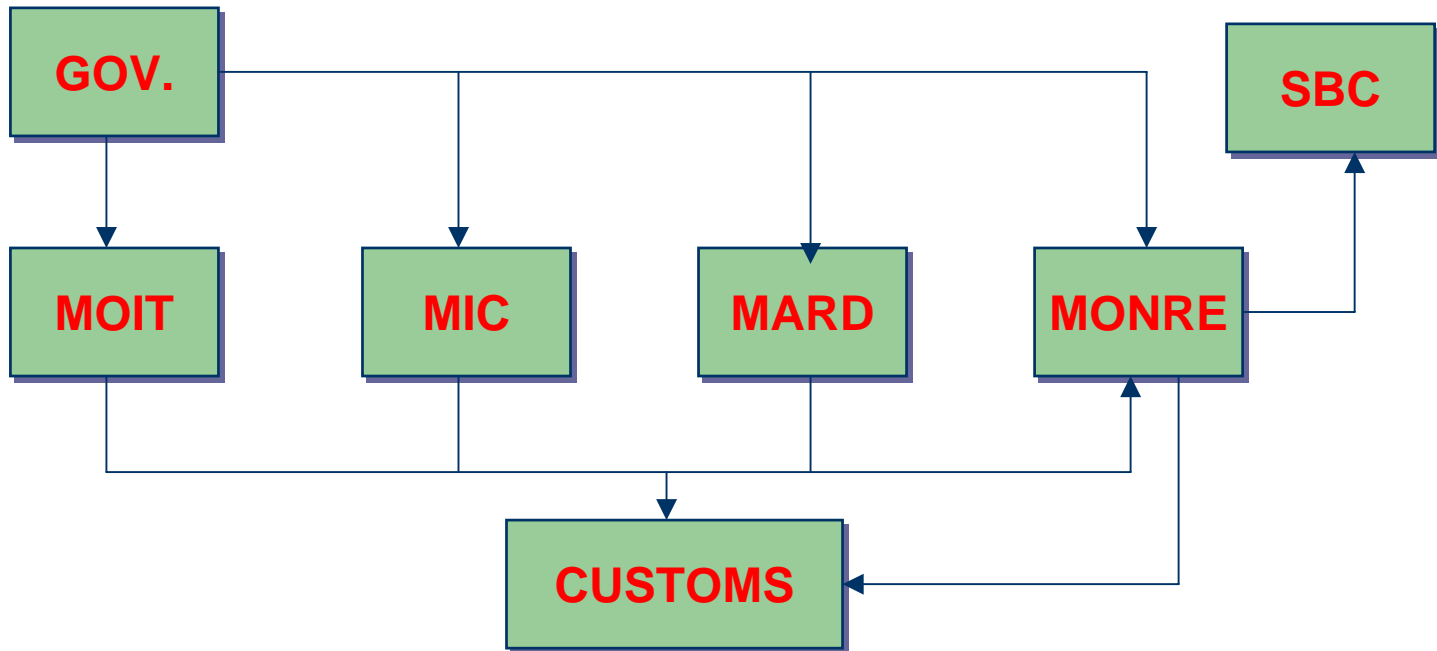
How the system work

- National Assembly:
 - Law on Environmental Protection
 - Law on Trade
- Government:
 - Decree 12/2006/ND-CP
- Ministry of Industry and Trade:
 - Regulates import, export of chemicals, uses consumer commodities, etc

How the system work

- Ministry of Information and Communication
 - Regulates Import, Export of used IT equipment
- Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development:
 - Regulates import, export of agricultural chemicals
- Ministry of NR and Environment
 - Regulates secondary materials
 - Notifies Parties to BC through SBC
