Brief review of Workshop 2008

- Difference of interpretation of waste might cause illegal trade and thus further research on distinguishing criteria on secondhand EEE was agreed to conduct.
- Shared common understandings that there are many worthsharing good practices on effective implementation.
- Recognized the necessity of improving Basel notification procedures in terms of processing time and accompanying documents.
- Agreed to regularly update the country's contact list, closely collaborate among the Asian countries, launch research projects, develop a reference material on good practices, and facilitate the implementation of E-wastes projects under Basel Convention.
