 - ➤ Wastes Listed in Annex III of the Basel Convention and Amber List of Wastes under the OECD System


□ Waste Control Act

- ➤ Mainly for domestic control of hazardous wastes
- **▶** Control of the Export and import of General Wastes(2008.8∼)
- Wastes except those controlled under the Act on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and their Disposal


2. Permission on the Exports and Imports of Hazardous Wastes

Permission on Exports of Wastes	 Permission granted when no technology or facilities are available domestically to treat wastes in a sound and proper manner, and such wastes are needed as raw materials for recycling industries of the state of import
Permission on Imports of Wastes	 Permission granted when the technology and facilities necessary to treat such wastes in a sound and proper manner are available When such wastes are used raw materials for recycling industries
Prohibition on Exports and Imports	 If there arises any cause to take any emergency measure for the environment and human health Any wastes that are feared to pose dangers to human health and the environment Being exported to any nation to lacks proper capacity to treat such wastes




6. Overview on Transboundary Movements of General Wastes

- ☐ Any person who desires to export or import general wastes shall notify the Minister of Environment
- ☐ Wastes imported must be disposed by the importers themselves, or consigned to treat by those who install and operate waste treatment facilities, or authorized wastehandlers
- ☐ Information on transferring imported wastes must be input to the electronic processing system
- ☐ Imported wastes are prohibited from re-importing just the way they are
