INTRODUCTION TO BCRC-SEA – HISTORY

1995

Article 14 of the Basel Convention requires the establishment of Regional Centers (BCRC)

Decision III/19 at COP III in 1995, Indonesia is selected to host one of BCRCs

1997

BCRC-SEA started operation

29 Oct 2005

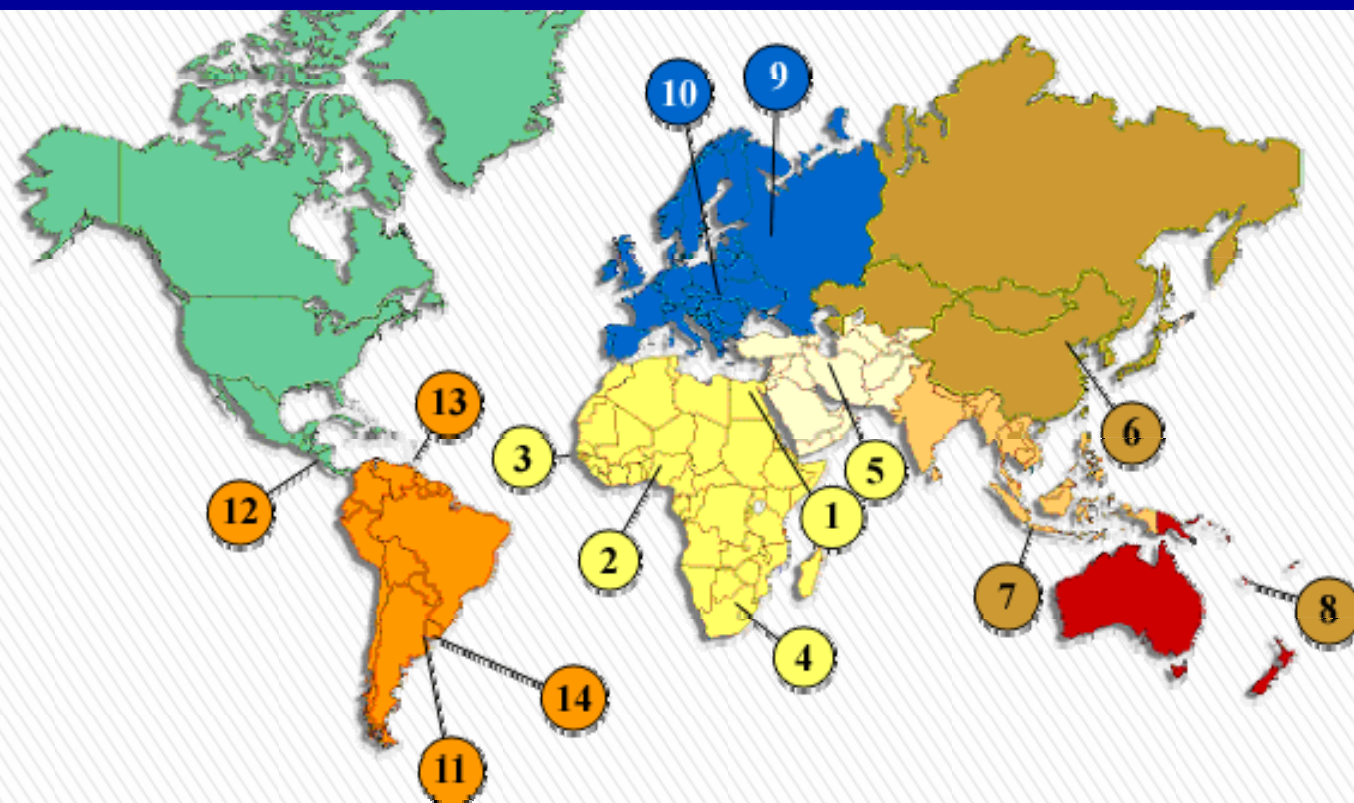
Indonesia signed the Framework Agreement on BCRC-SEA with SBC in Geneva

2006

BCRC-SEA re-established with new full-time director

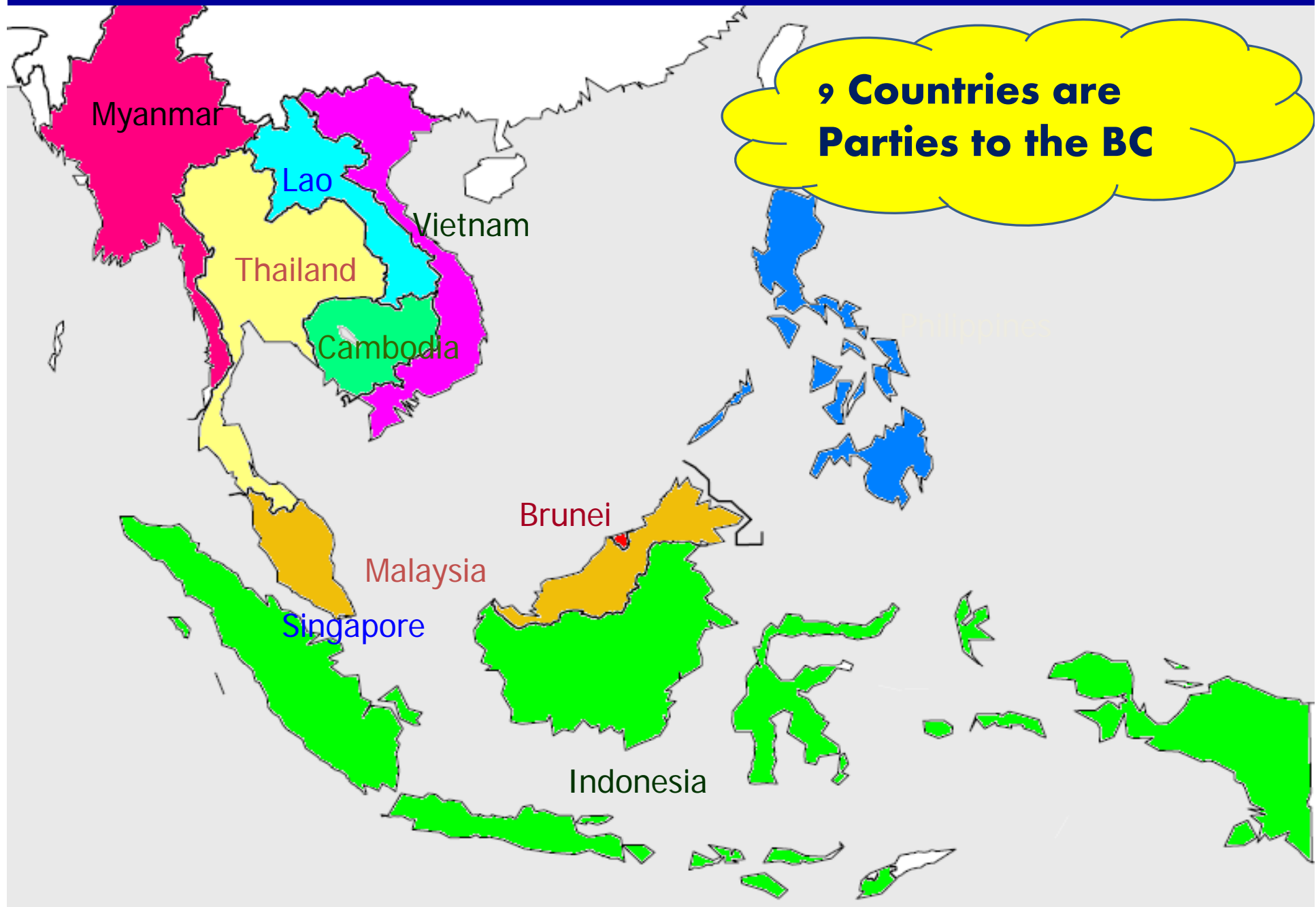

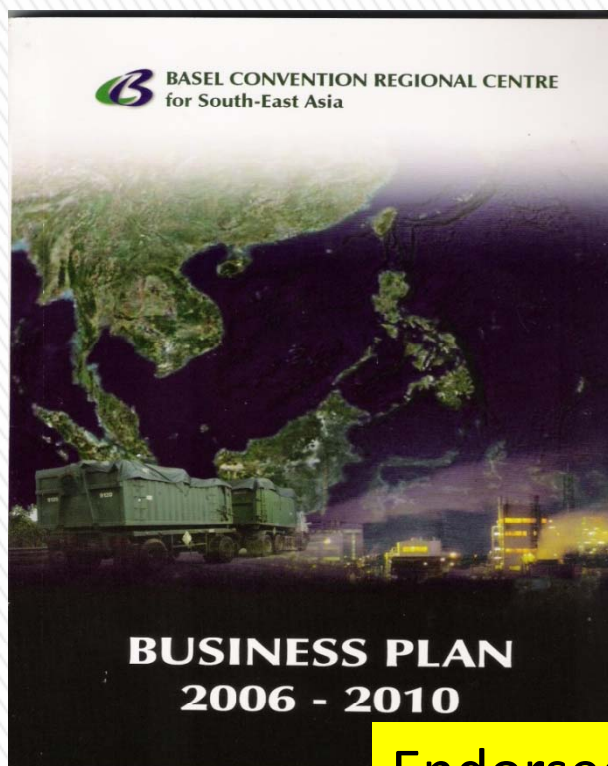

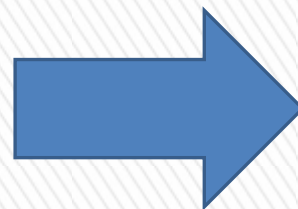

- » **Characteristics of ASEAN countries**
 - **Financial limitation**
 - **Administration process to host regional WS**
 - **etc**
- » **Difficulties to find donors for continuous activities**
- » **Clear division of functions among regional bodies – avoid overlapping**
