What we can do to promote ESM of wastes in the region

Training

To organize training workshops on specific technical guidelines to enhance the capacity building of the parties

information

To disseminate guidance on environmentally sound management through training, assistance and awareness-raising activities;
To collect and disseminate relevant news and information to the parties via newsletter, electronic poster and other materials

Technology transfer

To investigate and identify the technical demands of the parties especially the developing countries
Adapting relevant technical guidelines with national legislation

Seek further collaboration with other agencies, non-governmental organizations and the private sector;
Play an active role in Initiating national and regional partnership- work as a bridge



What we are doing to promote ESM of wastes

Information communication and delivery of ESM on waste in the region:

- **At present:**

- Tool of ESM in Chinese and delivering among stakeholders, 2011
- PACE guidelines regional training workshop , 2011
- Newsletter monthly: international updates on ESM and Transboundary movement have been collected and involved, and delivered to the parties in the region monthly since 2010



Plan to promote ESM of wastes in the region

1. Information communication and delivery of ESM on waste in the region:

- Organize the international conference(ICWMT) annually, in which ESM could be involved as one of main contents.
- Organize the regional workshop on sharing needs, updates and plan annually
- Newsletter monthly including undated activities of EMS as one of focused contents, and deliver to parties.



Plan to promote ESM of wastes in the region

2. Training on ESM Guidance documents on waste in the region:

- Regional Trainings on ESM guidance documents under BC
- Regional Trainings on PACE guidelines including ESM documents through internet (presenting the training video on the guidelines based on the coming PACE training workshop in this week)



Plan to promote ESM of wastes in the region

3. Capacity building of ESM on waste in the region:

- **Establishing information platform on ESM in the region based on the website of BCRC China, including the status, needs, updated activities.**
- **Projects to improve ESM of waste in the region and pilot, main contents:**
 - To investigate the information on current situation and needs to implement the Basel Convention focused on ESM in the selected countries;
 - To assist the countries to set up the system/plan to improve ESM of hazardous and other wastes;
 - To organize the regional workshop on information and practice of ESM



What capacity of BCRC should be strengthening to promote ESM?

Capacity Building for Staff

Through project cooperation, training, intership in other organizations based on projects or other cooperation.

Coordination and cooperation

To maintain and develop the regular and more coordination and cooperation among the parties and the BCRCs, and other international organizations.

Database And Information platform

To collect the data and information from the parties and then use the analysis to help the parities

Expertise

To analyze the need of the parties, and develop the own expertise of the BCRCs

Financial support

More possible funds support for the plan/activities mentioned above, such as information platform, regional workshop and training, other projects.



Suggestions to promote legal clarification

To undertake regional projects in investigating the current differences in different countries on the terms

Organizing of regional workshop on the basis of the above research

Developing of pilot technical guidelines in bilateral level
