

Conformity means business...

Only those operators that conform with the standards (or equivalent) can do business with the organisations of the WEEE Forum and WEEELABEX



Green light

Facility meets all essential requirements and is listed as 'WEELABEX facility'

Red light

Facility no longer meets the essential requirements and is thus de-listed

...dodgy operations means no business


How will the standards be rolled out?



Roadmap timeline



- 1. By 31/12/2012 Vanguard of 'early adopters' who voluntarily put WEEELABEX standards into practice. Gathers experiences gained. Will be provided visibility for its efforts.
- 2. By 31/12/2013 WEEE systems in 'old' member states implement standards
- 3. By 31/12/2014 WEEE systems in 'new' member states implement standards
- 4. Exemptions for relevant standards for those WEEE systems that cannot contractually impose standards or have no freedom to choose operators
- On the basis of feedback on implementation in 2011-12, GA will assess whether to provide exemptions on cost grounds
