1. Existing Regulations

- ➤ Sub-Decree No. 36 on Solid Waste Management (1999)
 - The import of hazardous waste is strictly prohibited
 - The export of hazardous waste is not prohibited, but to ensure the compliance with the Basel Convention

1. Existing Regulations (Cont.)

- > Sub-Decree No. 168 on Plastic Bags Management (2017)
 - The manufacturing and import of plastic bags are authorized only with permits granted by the Ministry of Environment
 - These permits require plastic bags to meet a minimum threshold thickness of 30 microns

2. Response to Plastic Amendment

- > Draft regulations on Plastic Products and Materials

 Management
- > Draft regulations on Hazardous Waste Management

2. Response to Plastic Amendment (Cont.)

- ➤ Amended Sub-Decree No. 209 to Sub-Decree No. 17 on the Enforcement of the List of Prohibited and Restricted Goods (2020)
 - The import of plastic waste is strictly prohibited
 - In case of domestic demand for production chain, some types of plastic waste are allowed to import but mostly free from contamination

• The export of plastic waste is not prohibited but shall comply with the Basel Convention

> Import and Export of Plastic Waste

Plastic Waste	2019	2020
Import (PE Flake)		173.742 Tons
Export	7,788 Tons	2,679.81 Tons
