

Summary of a report on the enforcement status of the Law Concerning Special Measures against Dioxins for FY 2009

1. Number of specified facilities (as of March 31, 2010) *

- Facilities subject to air standards: 11,391 facilities

(Number of business entities: 8,259)

- Facilities subject to effluent standards: 4,100 facilities

(Number of business entities: 1,846)
