UNCRD's Basic Strategy for 3R

<u>Promote 3R at ground level (bottom up approach)</u> <u>through;</u>

- response to the **real needs** of recipient countries with **visible outputs**, (tailored approach to real needs)

- understanding of economic/ environmental & resource management benefits (motivations and incentives)

- cooperation with other national/regional/international organizations (technical and financial)

<u>Through these activities, UNCRD aims to;</u> - support Sustainable Development

- provide support to achieve MDGs

Findings of the Missions

- Major concern in Asian countries;
- conventional waste management.
- About 3R/SPC/CP;
- limited integration of 3R in governmental policies
- limited awareness among public, media, and industry especially of SMEs
- limited numbers of trained personnel
- limited knowledge on technology, good practice, etc
