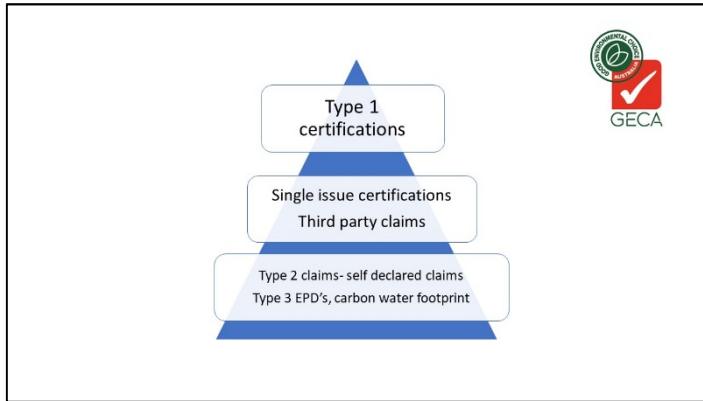

**Who is GECA?**

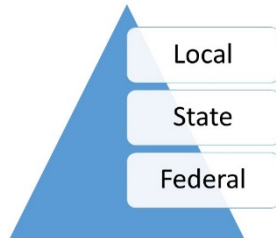
