

Outline of the Acid Deposition Monitoring Network in East Asia (EANET)



- Started operation in January 2001 with the aim of establishing a regional cooperation mechanism on acid deposition problems in East Asia.
- Currently 13 countries are participating.

Scope Expansion

- At the Intergovernmental Meeting held in 2020, it was agreed to expand the scope of activities to address **wider atmospheric environment-related issues** from the acid deposition.
- At the Meeting in 2021, the specific atmospheric environment-related substances and activities to be covered by the expanded scope and the guidelines for the new EANET Project Fund were adopted.

Direction of future implementation and its activities

- **Sustainable monitoring**(Including methodological exchange on satellite monitoring)
- **Nitrogen cycle monitoring and assessment**(Effective use of accumulated data and expertise)
- **Co-benefit of air pollution and climate change**(Including enhancing access to existing financial mechanisms)
