## Outline of the Acid Deposition Monitoring Network in East Asia (EANET)





- Started operation in January 2001 with the aim of establishing a regional cooperation mechanism on acid deposition problems in East Asia.
- Currently 13 countries are participating.

## **Scope Expansion**

- At the Intergovernmental Meeting held in 2020, it was agreed to expand the scope of activities to address <u>wider atmospheric environment-related</u> <u>issues</u> from the acid deposition.
- At the Meeting in 2021, the specific atmospheric environment-related substances and activities to be covered by the expanded scope and the guidelines for the new EANET Project Fund were adopted.

## Direction of future implementation and its activities

- <u>Sustainable monitoring</u>(Including methodological exchange on satellite monitoring)
- Nitrogen cycle monitoring and assessment(Effective use of accumulated data and expertise)
- <u>Co-benefit of air pollution and climate change</u>(Including enhancing access to existing financial mechanisms)
