Acid Deposition Monitoring Network in East Asia (EANET)





Establishment of EANET

- Started its operation in January 2001 with the aim of establishing a regional cooperation mechanism on acid deposition problems in East Asia.
- Currently 13 countries are participating.

Scope Expansion

- At the Intergovernmental Meeting held in 2020, participating countries agreed to expand the scope of activities to address wider atmospheric environment-related issues from the acid deposition.
- At the Meeting in 2021, the specific atmospheric environment-related substances and activities to be covered by the expanded scope and the guidelines for the new EANET Project Fund were adopted.
