





INDCs: Scope and Upfront Information


- Scope: Mitigation only vs Comprehensive ? [What was decided at COP20]
 - Upfront information is mitigation centric
 - Party may consider adaptation polices
 - No direct reference to means of implementation
- Upfront information: Mandatory? Common format? [What was decided at COP20]
 - Mitigation-centric information which may be included
 - Quantifiable information
 - Planning processes
 - How the Party considers that its INDC is fair and ambitious, in light of its national circumstances, and how it contributes towards achieving the UNFCCC objective

INDCs: Timing and Ex-ante Consultation

- The word "intended" implies that INDCs would be subject to ex-ante consultation.
 - Form of ex-ante consultation?
 - Earlier submission of INDCs?


[What was decided at COP20]

- No ex-ante consultation on individual INDCs before COP21.
- Synthesis report on aggregate effect, but no further work at COP21.



INDC Cycle: An Idea

A cycle for reviewing and submitting subsequent nationally determined contributions after the initial submission in 2015




Inputs

- Assessment of aggregate ambition
- Assessment of each INDCs using various equity indicators
- Assessment of mitigation potentials that are untapped by INDCs
- Assessment of opportunities and benefits that INDC could bring.

Options for Anchoring NDCs in a Paris Agreement

• How should the balance between legal clarity and flexibility be taken?



The Way Forward

- A dynamic cycle for periodically improving subsequent (I)NDCs should be established.
- The 2015 Agreement should contain legal obligation to submit and implement NDCs, while the NDCs will be kept in a registry (non-legal instrument).
- "Research Consortium" can provide inputs to the cycle.
 - Aggregate ambition
 - > Equity
 - Mitigation potentials
 - Opportunities
