• Location	East Asian countries which participate in the East Asia Summit Environment Ministers Meeting (EAS-EMM)
 Project Background 	In recent years, East Asia has experienced rapid industrialization, population growth and urban growth, which has resulted in considerable environmental change. The first EAS-EMM was held in Vietnam in 2008, where ministers agreed that environmentally sustainable cities (ESC) were to be the priority areas for EAS environmental cooperation. Japan proposed the EAS EMM High Level Seminar (HLS) on ESC in order to contribute to relevant activities, and the 1st HLS was held in Indonesia in 2010 and the 2nd HLS in Kitakyushu in 2011.
Objectives	In order to promote the development of ESC in East Asia, central governments, local gov- ernments, international organizations, aid agencies, research institutes, NGOs and other bodies gather together in the Seminar, share knowledge, measures and activities regard- ing the environmental model cities. Based on the activities above, the Seminar aims at promoting and expanding cooperation between relevant parties.
Member Countries	Japan, China, Korea, Australia, New Zealand, India, Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam
