Bangkok has set an ambitious long-term goal of achieving “Net Zero by 2050” and is actively working on climate action. This project, based on the partnership between Yokohama City and the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA), provides policy support and strengthens public-private collaboration to advance the implementation of Bangkok's Climate Change Master Plan. Key initiatives include establishing and managing a platform to foster public-private partnerships, implementing an energy action plan to accelerate the Master Plan, and developing greenhouse gas reduction projects through the JCM.
