

City-to-City Collaboration Seminar 2026 Held in Ehime Prefecture



Overview

On February 5–6, the [Seminar on City-to-City Collaboration for a Zero-Carbon Society 2026](#) was held in Ehime Prefecture, Japan. Following opening remarks by Mr. Doi, Vice-Minister for Global Environmental Affairs at the Ministry of the Environment, Japan (MOEJ), and Governor Nakamura of Ehime Prefecture, presentations were delivered by Governor Ismail of Gorontalo Province, Indonesia, as well as representatives from a local company (Aiken Kakoki K.K.), the MOEJ, and a private consulting firm (JAPAN NUS Co., Ltd.). In the panel discussion, active exchanges took place among panelists from the MOEJ, Ehime Prefecture, Toyama City (Japan), Pohnpei State (Federated States of Micronesia), and Airai State (Palau) on the role and potential of city-to-city collaboration in an era of increasing uncertainty in intergovernmental cooperation.

The seminar attracted a total of 260 participants, including online attendees.
