

City-to-City Collaboration Seminar 2026: Mutual Learning and Insights from Ongoing Research Activities



Overview

In the current fiscal year, the City-to-City Collaboration Program involves 10 countries and 47 cities, with 25 research projects currently underway. As part of the [City-to-City Collaboration Seminar 2026](#) held on February 5–6, approximately 120 stakeholders from all projects gathered in Ehime Prefecture to foster momentum for regional decarbonization.

During the closed-door mutual learning session, participants introduced their respective projects through group discussions, deepening their understanding of the program while engaging in active exchanges of views.

By learning from a wide range of diverse and unique initiatives, the session is expected to generate new insights and contribute to the development of future projects.
