

[Decarbonization City-to-City Collaboration] Bali's Gianyar Regency and Ōsaki Town Sign Letter of Intent (LOI) for Mutual Cooperation



Overview

On November 27, 2025, the Mayor of Ōsaki Town, the Chairperson of the Ōsaki Town Assembly, and a delegation from the project operator, So Recycle Center Co., Ltd., visited the Gianyar Regency Office in Bali Province and signed a Letter of Intent (LOI) expressing mutual interest in cooperation.

Ōsaki Town has continued international cooperation since 2012 through projects such as JICA initiatives. Its efforts have been highly evaluated, including a village in Bali Province receiving an environmental improvement award.

This signing aims to transfer the know-how of the Ōsaki System through public-private collaboration, support the resource recovery of waste and the creation of economic value, and promote sustainable community development.

Moving forward, the two towns will aim to establish a formal sister city agreement in the field of environmental management to achieve a decarbonized society. They will strive to develop a long-term, formal partnership for mutual sharing of knowledge, experience, and solutions to address environmental issues.
