

Renewed the MoU between MPCB and Osaka City on collaboration in the field of environment conservation and energy



Overview

On 12 January 2026, the Osaka City Environment Bureau and the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) held the renewal ceremony in Mumbai for the “MoU on collaboration in the field of environment conservation and energy between the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board and the Osaka City Environment Bureau”, which was signed on 24 June 2020. The ceremony was held in the presence of Mr. Yagi Koji, Consul-General of Japan in Mumbai , and coverage of the event appeared in Indian newspapers.

This MOU promotes cooperative efforts between the two parties with a view to preserving and improving the environment and achieving decarbonization in sectors such as energy within the Maharashtra state. Moving forward, Osaka City and GEC shall aim to support environmental improvements in the state by sharing the expertise, know-how and technologies of Osaka City and private-sector companies, particularly in the fields of waste management, water environment and air pollution control.
