

Asia Smart City Conference 2025 was Held by City of Yokohama



Overview

The Asia Smart City Conference, an international conference for discussing the realization of sustainable urban development, was held in Yokohama from November 25 to 27, 2025. At the conference, City of Yokohama served as the initiating city and, together with other cities in Asian countries such as the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration and Makassar City, publicly called on international organizations to establish a new institutional framework to promote circular cities in Asia. In response, ICLEI Japan announced the establishment of the Asian Circular Cities Declaration (ACCD). The City of Yokohama welcomed delegations from overseas cities and international organizations, and the further strengthening of international cooperation was confirmed at the mayoral meetings with the Mayor of City of Yokohama. In addition, business matchmaking sessions and meetings were organized with overseas delegations and Japanese companies in Yokohama to advance public-private partnership initiatives.
