

Installation of Biomass Equipment at Hasanuddin University

Overview

Maniwa City and Makassar City are aiming to build a recycling system for organic waste, referencing the “Maniwa Model,” and this year is the second year of the project.

In September 2025, as a pilot activity, biomass equipment was installed at Hasanuddin University in Makassar City, which has active exchanges with Okayama University. This project has just started treating organic waste within the university.

Moving forward, to work toward the JCM Equipment Subsidy Project, we will strengthen collaboration not only between Maniwa City and Makassar City but also between universities and various institutions to realize the establishment of an organic waste recycling system in Makassar City.
