

Launched a Business that Involves Composting Food Waste and Growing Vegetables for Hotels in Collaboration with the Japan Junior Chamber (JC)



Overview

Under the City-to-city collaboration project of Toyama City–Badung Regency, local companies are collaborating to address waste management challenges in Bali.

The Junior Chamber International Japan’s “SMILE by ACTION Project” in Pererenan Village promotes a circular model that uses food-waste compost to grow vegetables for hotels.

In coordination with the city-to-city initiative, composting facilities and a business model have been introduced. This study aims to expand the model across Bali, where resort hotels are widespread.
