

# City-to-City Collaboration between Bali Province and Semarang City in Indonesia and Toyama City

Bali, as a global tourist destination, has been promoting environmental programs and policies to improve the rapidly deteriorating environment. Among them, CO<sub>2</sub> emissions from transportation and air pollution are priority issues, and the province's comprehensive energy plan states that gas use in the transportation field and renewable energy development should be expanded. Therefore, in order to solve the problem by converting diesel fuel to natural gas, Bali Province requested the state-owned gas company (Pertamina Gas)to improve the supply infrastructure and requested Toyama city for policy and technical support since it has experience of fuel conversion for public transportation in Semarang city.
