

# City-to-City Collaboration between Quezon City and Osaka City

Osaka City and Quezon City began collaboration in 2015 through a project for the Ministry of the Environment, and have been participating in City-to-City collaboration projects since 2017. In 2018, Osaka City and Quezon City signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) on cooperation to develop a low-carbon city and have continued policy dialogue. The MOU was renewed to further deepen and expand cooperation for the zero carbon development of Quezon City in 2021.

## Quezon City

Quezon City is a C40 member and is known as a leading city for environmental efforts. Quezon has set a goal of reducing CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 30% by 2030 and pursuing net zero emissions by 2050.

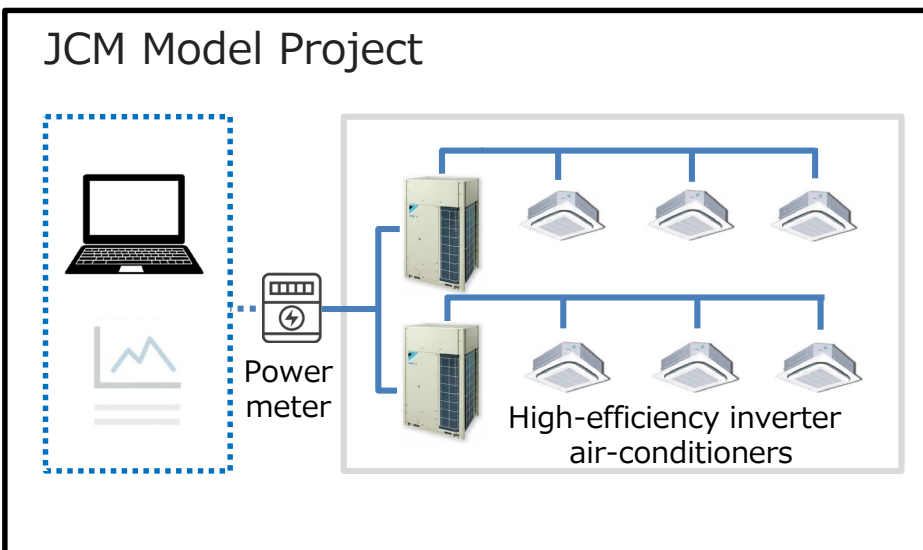
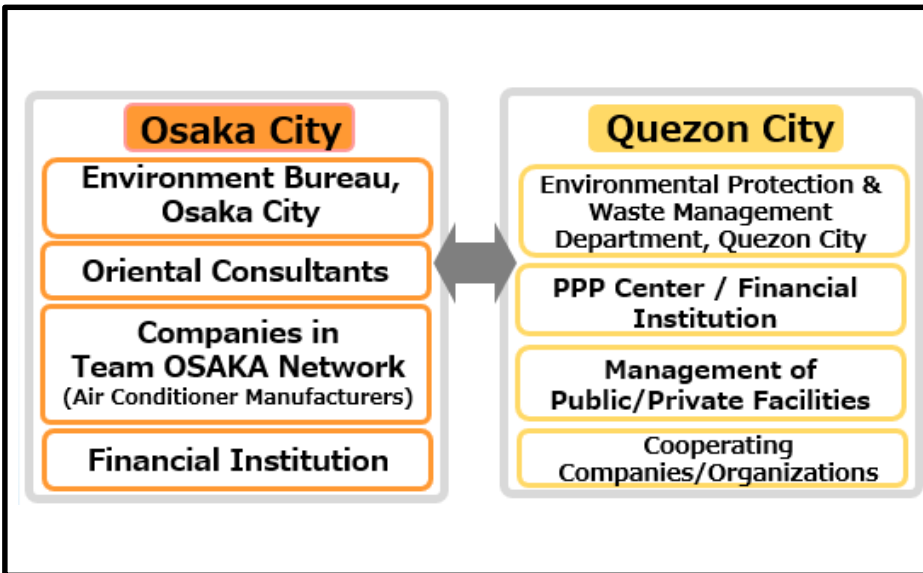


## Osaka City

Osaka City declared a goal of achieving net zero CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 2050 and shares its experience and know-how of the zero carbon development to support Quezon City. The city also promotes the development of zero carbon society projects through Team OSAKA Network, a public-private partnership platform.

## <Project Activity>

- Application for the JCM Model Project to install energy saving air conditioning units in government buildings
- Examination of the possibility of expanding the project to other public and private facilities
- Support for fluorocarbon handling measures required due to air conditioning upgrades
- Support for environmental policies in Quezon City (installation of LED lighting in government buildings, adoption of EV buses for the city bus system, technology to reduce plastic waste, etc.)
- Study for responding to new needs due to the COVID-19 pandemic
- Formulation of a future action plan for City-to-City Collaboration activities
- Four workshops held for information sharing

## <Achievement>

- Renewal of the MOU between Quezon City and Osaka City to develop zero-carbon cities
- Adoption of JCM Model Project: Introduction of Energy Saving Air Conditioning System to Quezon City Hall Compound
- Implementation of the F-gas JCM project
- Development of next activity plans based on the analysis of Quezon City's Enhanced Local Climate Change Action Plan (LCCAP) 2021-2050
