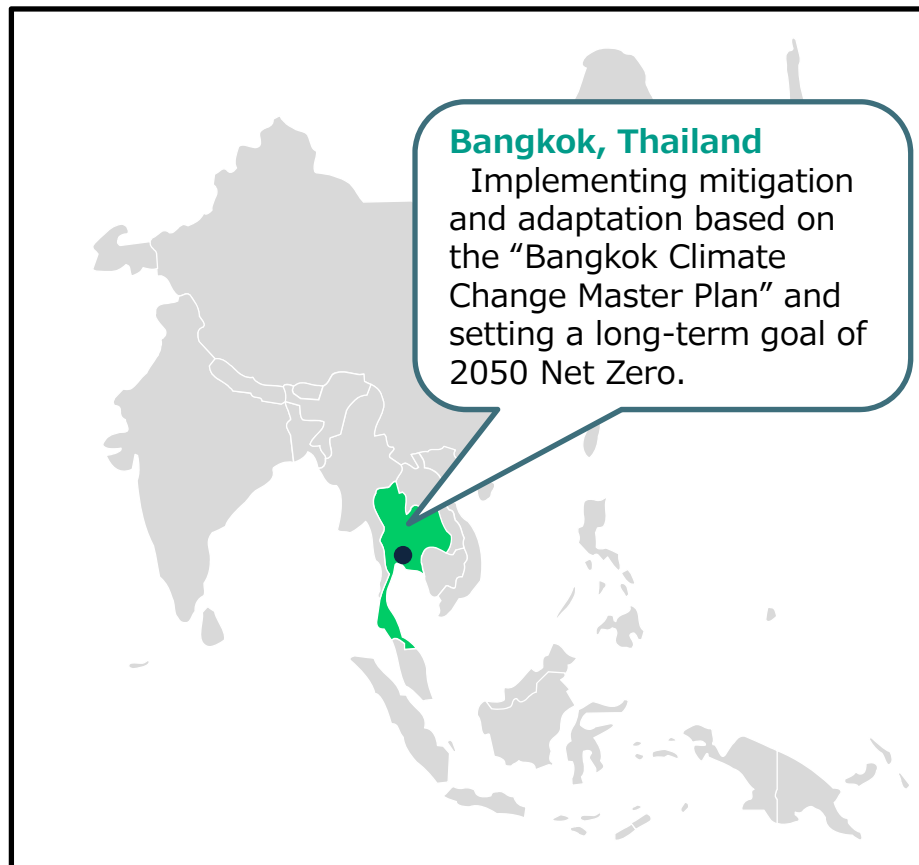


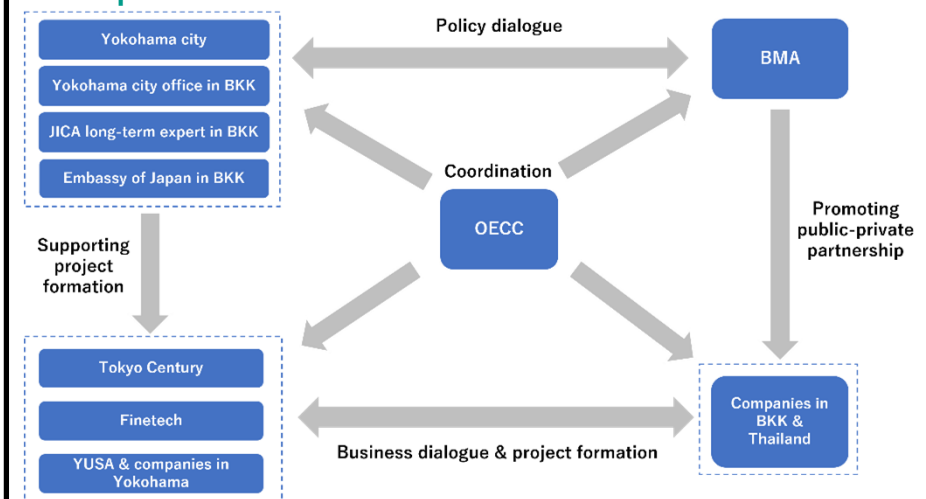
City-to-City Collaboration between Bangkok and City of Yokohama

Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) and City of Yokohama concluded a MOU on technical cooperation for environmentally sustainable urban development in BMA in 2013, and have supported the formulation and implementation of the "Bangkok Climate Change Master Plan". This project promotes public-private partnerships based on the cooperative relationship between the two cities and promote efforts to decarbonize Bangkok at both the policy and project levels.

•Activities :

- Organized a city to city project session in "Bangkok Climate and Energy Action Conference toward Net Zero GHG Emission" (Aug. 2022).
- Organized an online workshop "Net Zero Emissions Business Opportunity" (Nov. 2022).
- Organized 2nd Workshop "Net Zero Emissions Business Opportunity" (Nov. 2022).
- Shared Yokohama City's knowledge and experience for preparation of the Energy Action Plan
- Conducted onsite surveys for project formation

•Outcomes :

- Promoted exchanges between the 2 cities and private companies through organizing multiple events and lead to collaboration for project formation.
- Developing the Energy Action Plan with support from the City of Yokohama and experts.
- Found several project seeds through field surveys and discussed MRV methodology and used of JCM financing program.
