#### Youth Statement

#### Tripartite (China, Japan, and the Republic of Korea) Youth Statement on Environmental Problems

The Tripartite Environment Student Summit (TESS) 2009

Nagoya, Japan 14<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> November 2009

#### Preamble

We, the representatives from China, Japan, and the Republic of Korea, gathered for the Tripartite Environment Student Summit (TESS) 2009. During the summit, we exchanged our opinions about our environmental activities in our own countries. We also discussed environmental problems in the three countries, what our generation can do to solve the problems while building a stronger relationship among the three countries.

Based on the discussions we had during the summit, we have made the following statement. In the first part, we focus on our awareness of the present situation. Secondly our call on various agencies to promote the environmental cooperation among the three countries is stated. And the third part is on what we, youth, can do and want to do to promote our cooperation.

#### Our Awareness of the Present Situation

China, Japan, and the Republic of Korea account for 22% of the world population and for 70% of the total GDP of the Asia region, making the three countries very important in the world politics and economy. For that reason, they have a large influence on world environmental problems such as climate change (about one fourth of the GHG emissions of the world are attributed to the three countries) and the loss of biodiversity. At the regional level, the three countries have cross-border environmental problems such as the yellow sand and the E-waste problem, and possess similar domestic problems including waste management in the cities and pollution.

The three countries have a strong relationship in the environmental field at the government level, such as Tripartite Environment Ministers Meeting (TEMM), and Tripartite Environmental Education Network (TEEN). However, because of the historical issues and the language barrier, our cooperation is still not enough.

#### Our Vision

In order to solve the environmental problems at the regional and the global level, the cooperation among China, Japan and the Republic of Korea is essential.

We think that our three countries face similar environmental problems. These problems are not only tightly related to youth's future but also determine all human beings' future. We have to cooperate with each other, which is an effective way to solve these problems. The cooperation should be promoted by the governments, corporations, NGOs and researchers, and the citizens.

#### We Call On

#### National governments

- to strengthen the network among the three countries, holding more meetings on environmental problems.
- to support more youth activities making efforts to solve national environmental problems and to make sustainable networks of the three countries.

#### Corporations

- to improve and share the green technology(such as clean energy) in each country, because we suffer from similar problems, such as waste management and pollution.
- to create more green jobs by promoting Corporate Social Responsibility activities.

#### NGOs and Researchers

- to organize regular meetings with counterparts of the three countries and study how their activities build a reciprocal relationship.
- to exchange the outcomes of their researches and find how their works make a better life.

#### Citizens

to join more grass-roots environmental activities and change their lifestyles into more sustainable ones.

#### What We, Youth, Can Do and Want To Do To Promote Cooperation.

We, youth of the three countries, have already been doing various kinds of environmental activities, and made several networks through international conferences and other environmental events. However, our national activities currently suffer from many limitations. Therefore, in order to make our activities more significant and more influential, we will commit ourselves to make the network stronger and larger, and to do the following activities.

- · Make an eco-website in order to share information of the environmental situation and activities systematically.
- · Adopt each other's eco-campus activity, since we already have creative campus-based activities in each country.
- · Visit each country and plan eco-tours, where we can feel the real nature and raise awareness to conserve it.

These youth activities will lead to the solution of environmental problems among three countries, and we can protect our beautiful planet, the earth.



Day 1 (Sat. 14<sup>th</sup> Nov.)

#### (1) オープニング、アイスブレーキング

開催挨拶一環境省、九反田様

環境省の九反田様より開催の挨拶をいただき、参加者は3カ国間でTESSを開催する背景、また、会議およびその後のネットワーク構築の重要性を認識した。





#### (2) 日中韓における環境活動の先進事例共有と意見交換

各国の参加者が学生の優れた環境活動に関する発表を行った。発表は各国の学生環境活動の概要、優良事例や課題などを含み、質疑応答でも活発な議論が行われ、類似点や相違点の整理をはじめとし、今後の3カ国連携や各国の活動の更なる発展にむけて有意義な時間となった。

#### (3) 各国ネットワーク団体の活動紹介と課題の共有及び意見交換

各国には全国規模のネットワークやプラットホーム組織があり、各団体の活動や 組織体系について発表を行った。各国でその形態は異なり、どのように効果的に 活動を続けられるのか、また3カ国で連携できるのかについて質疑応答でも活発 な議論が行われ、国内的視点、国際的視点の相互から将来についての議論を深め た。









#### (1) 基調講演「東アジアにおける市民の環境協力」

―廣瀬稔也氏(東アジア環境情報発伝所)

東アジアにおける環境問題の現状と、この分野における市民レベルでの協力についての講義をうけた。また、その後、3カ国が環境問題に関して協力することの難しさと重要性に関してディスカッションを行った。

#### (2) グループワーク 1 - 現状把握

-各グループ 5 人程度、3 グループにわかれグループワークを行った。

- 1. SWOT 分析-3 カ国ユースの環境協力について
- 2. 強みと機会を活かして私達に何ができるのか、弱みと脅威をどのように克服すべきか。
- 2題目に関して、ブレインストーミングと意見交換を行い、模造しにポストイットを用いて図示した。この模造紙を用いてそれぞれ 3 分程度の発表を行い、他グループおよび廣瀬氏からのフィードバックを得た。





#### (3) グループワーク2ーアクションプラン "日中韓学生環境ネットワーク"

-ヒーローインタビューとアクションプランのトピック選び

参加者がペアを作り、お互いの夢が実現してインタビューを受けているという設定で、それぞれ将来どうしてい

きたいのかということを把握、共有しあった。その後、3 カ国の環境問題解決 に貢献しうる実際の行動計画としての「アクションプラン」案を各自がワーク シートに落とし込み、全員で共有した。最後に、参加者が協力して実行に移す アクションプラン案を3つ選択した。



#### (4) 共同宣言文

会議前からメールベースで議論を進めてきた共同宣言文案を3パートにわけてグループごとに修正点を話あい、改訂を加えた。最終的には16日の朝に全パートの最終チェックを全員で行い、最終合意としての共同宣言文を策定した。



#### (1) 発表準備

Tripartite Environmental Education Network (TEEN) シンポジウムにおける発表に向け、参加者は発表準備を行った。発表の項目としては、

- -TESS の概要
- -3 カ国のユース環境活動紹介
- -共同宣言文
- -日中間学生環境ネットワーク構想(3つのアクションプラン)

午前中は、発表用のパワーポイントを仕上げ、リハーサルを通じて、修正やより効果的な発表方法について議論した。



(2) TEEN シンポジウム 13:00-16:15 於:名古屋国際会議場 主催:環境省 第3部にて与えられた15分間の発表時間において、7名の参加者およびスタッフ1名が、TEEN参加者にむけ上述の 発表を行った。聴衆は、大学教授や政府の職員、市民などで、興味深く聞いていただいた。

#### TEEN レセプション

シンポジウム後は、TEEN のレセプションに参加し、TEEN の参加者とも更なる交流を深める機会を得た。



#### Day 4 (Tue. 17<sup>th</sup> Nov.)

#### (1) 愛知臨空新エネルギーパーク、実証実験エリアおよび新エネルギー体験館

新エネルギー体験館内で施設全体についての説明をうけ、その後、太陽光発電は Nas バッテリーなどの最新技術を見て回り、最後に新エネルギー体験館内で、電気バイクや自転車発電といった体験、スマートグリッド模型や風力実験など様々な技術を参加者自ら体験することができた。



#### (2) 常滑セラミックモール

愛知の伝統文化である常滑焼の販売、展示等を行う大型モール地帯に立ち寄り、 日中韓の伝統文化について学ぶとともに、買い物や散策を楽しんだ。



#### (3) クロージング 於:中部国際空港

愛知県庁の宇都木様より閉会の挨拶をいただく。その後、日本人参加者が作成した TESS 全体を振り返るビデオを鑑賞し、各国参加者から、TESS を開催した環境省や愛知県への感謝とともに、今後に向けた決意が語られた。また各国のアドバイザーからも会議総括及び諸機関への感謝、参加者へ今後にむけたメッセージが語られ、TESS の全プログラムは終了した。



その後、参加者は空港の待合室に移動し集合写真を撮り、今後ともこの会議で 生まれた 3 カ国のつながりを保ち続け、アクションプランを実行に移していく ことも誓った。




