best practices - what works?



- Public Private Partnership (Conflicts of Interests)
- 100% reliance on Treasury funds (*thin* Budget margins)
- Co-financing (limited only to in kind)
- Project follow up mechanisms (Absence of financial commitments)

lessons learned - What doesn't work?



Having a financing mechanism through partnership & networking for follow up activities of Projects (post-project period), could ensure the long term sustainability of project benefits.
