


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Map 1: Location of Papua New Guinea






FIVE REDD+ Pilot Provinces


















PNGFA/JICA major Challenges with local communities

- 1. Customary Ownership by Clans (Land Tenure System) quite unique compared to other countries not documented and no surveyed boundaries
- 2. Resource owners want incentives to protect their forest areas
- 3. Transportation and accessibility problems
- 4. FPIC process at local communities tough and expensive exercise
- 5. Most resource owners are literate but lack writing & reading skills
- 6. No proper collaboration between stakeholders/institutions
- 7. Lack of awareness and capacity building at the local level
- 8. Shifting Cultivation no law on forest clearance
- 9. No proper report on fire (both forest & anthropogenic)
- 10. No proper report on non wood forest products (NWFP) removals
- 11. Insufficient resources finance and man power
- 12. Data sharing problems due to limitation in licensing
- 13. Communication
