#### Actions prior to 2020 and preparation for NDC implementation

- ✓ It is necessary to start preparing for implementation, by translating NDCs into sectoral roadmaps and policies, and mainstreaming NDC implementation across government.
- ✓ For plans of implementation, it is important to take both <u>top-down and bottom up approaches</u>, by engaging the economy, planning and finance ministries, to undertake economic modelling and allocate roles of line ministries, and consultation with line ministries for mitigation options.
- ✓ Budgetary arrangements are crucial to implement NDCs in a sustainable manner. *National budget should be fundamental*, while external support through multilateral and bilateral financial arrangements and international private investment are still important.

# Existing reporting framework and post-2020 transparency framework

- ✓ For built-in flexibility, suggestions were made for <u>options for</u> <u>gradual adjustment</u>, <u>including parallel improvement</u>, <u>convergence</u>, <u>capacity-differentiation</u> (with tiered approach), and differentiation by commitment types.
- ✓ While flexibility should be allowed for countries with different capacities, all countries should continue to build on their experiences and improve their transparency over time as capacity improves.
- ✓ In the Asia-Pacific region, there is already significant work for sharing and replicating experiences through information reported under the transparency framework.
