1. The Historic Paris Agreement

Paris Agreement (2015)

- Article 2
 - 1. "...aims to strengthen the global response to the threat of climate change..."
 - (a) "Holding the increase in the global average temperature to well below 2°C above pre-industrial levels and pursuing efforts to limit the temperature increase to 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels..."
- Article 4
 - 1. "...achieve a balance between anthropogenic emissions by sources and removals by sinks of greenhouse gases in the second half of this century..."
- Article 10
 - 5. "Accelerating, encouraging and enabling innovation is critical for an effective, long-term global response to climate change and promoting economic growth and sustainable development."




