In October 2020, Prime Minister Suga Yoshihide declared that Japan will aim to reduce greenhouse gas emissions to net-zero by 2050, that is, to realize a carbon-neutral, decarbonized society. To achieve a carbon-neutral, decarbonized society, technological innovation is required in every aspect, from energy and industry to resource circulation and lifestyles.

The exhibits at this pavilion explain some of the current technologies and initiatives of the companies that are striving to produce the innovations that will decarbonize Japan.

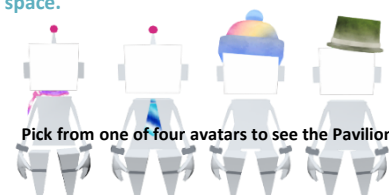
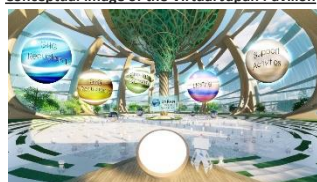
◎ Collaboration Partners | Approx. 30 companies/organizations in Japan (planned)
