- Thorough implementation of feeding management, including feeding forage (grass, hay, etc.) whose radiation levels are below the reference values
 - and
- Promotion of decontamination measures including inversion tillage in pastures where production of grass whose radiation levels are below the reference values is difficult

On farms, thorough implementation of feeding management, including feeding forage whose radiation levels are below the reference values is ensured.
