# INDCs

- Technical Support to 35 countries before Paris
  - Training workshops and in country "hand holding", support on methodologies for analysis and development of mitigation and adaptation options, etc.
  - The INDCs have generally been cooperative efforts of Ministries responsible for Climate Change, and Ministries responsible for implementing Sustainable development actions of the country.
- Updating and moving towards NDCs
  - Countries supported has requested continued support in:
    - updating and integrating INDCs in national planning
    - institutional arrangements to ensure implementation
    - building national structures for MRV and transparency
    - general support for implementing national commitments

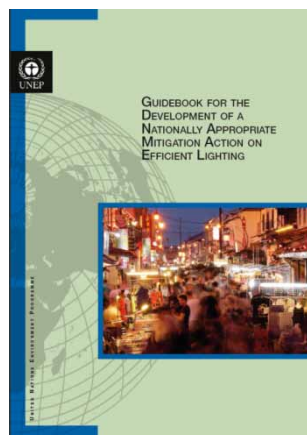

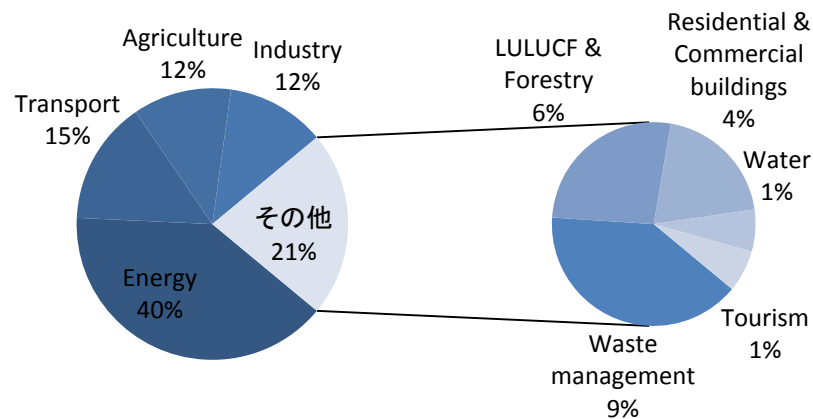

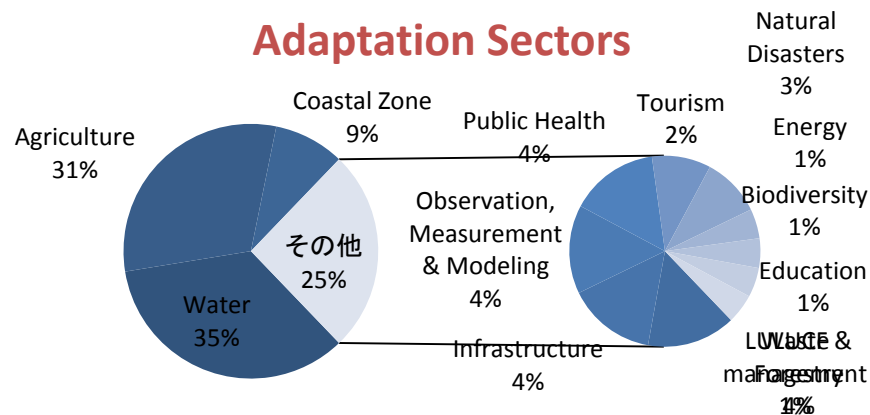


# TNA/TAP

## Adaptation Sectors

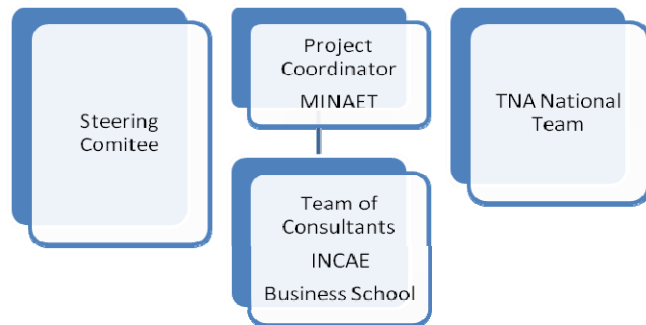


- First phase - 30 National TAPs completed

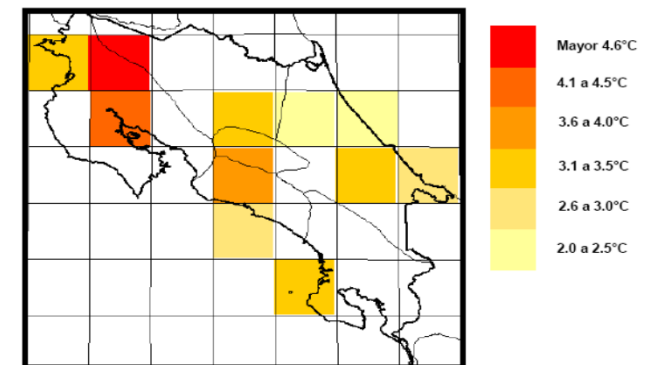
