Eleventh meeting of the Open-ended Working Group (OEWG-11)

- 3-6 September 2018, at CICG in Geneva
- Co-Chairs: Ms. Justina Grigaraviciene (Lithuania) (Technical) and Mr. Mohammed Khashashneh (Jordan) (Legal)



- Approx. 350 participants representing 132
 Parties and 34 observer entities
- Donors: Denmark, Finland, Germany, Japan, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland
- During OEWG-11: High-level event on Marine Litter and M-cube art installation



Eleventh meeting of the Open-ended Working Group (OEWG-11)

- 3 days of plenary in the six UN official languages
- Contact groups on strategic, technical (including a sub-group on marine litter) and legal matters met throughout the meeting







Outcomes of OEWG-11

Strategic matters

- Strategic framework:
 - Secretariat to finalize the draft compilation of information related to the indicators to be used for the preparation of the final evaluation of the strategic framework for COP-14 consideration
- Developing ESM guidelines:
 - EWG to finalise draft guidance documents and manuals for COP-14 consideration

Scientific and technical matters

- POPs technical guidelines:
 - Norway, the Secretariat, SIWG to revise draft new or updated general and specific technical guidelines for consideration and possible adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its fourteenth meeting





- E-waste technical guidelines:
 - Took note of the suggestions of the EWG for amendments to the technical guidelines
 - Recommended that COP-14 consider amending the e-waste technical guidelines as suggested by the EWG, taking into account the OEWG-11 discussions
- Technical guidelines on incineration on land (D10) and on specially engineered landfill (D5):
 - Commenting period for both sets of guidelines before COP-14
 - Updated drafts submitted for COP-14 consideration



- National reporting:
 - Agreed on the types of wastes for which practical guidance on the development of inventories should be developed (for COP-14 consideration)
- Marine litter and Microplastics:
 - Agreed that draft elements set out in the annex to the OEWG decision should be a basis for a decision by COP-14
 - Recommends to COP-14 the establishment of a partnership under the Basel Convention on plastic wastes
- Amendments to annexes:
 - Recommends COP-14 consider whether to amend entry B3010 on solid plastic waste in Annex IX to the Convention and, if so, in what form;
 - Took note of the intention of the Government of Norway to submit a proposal to amend Annex II to COP-14





- Electronic approaches to notification and movement documents:
 - Recommendations to COP-14: report, consultative workshops
- Waste containing nanomaterials:
 - Commenting period on report on issues related to waste containing nanomaterials and options for further work under the Basel Convention

Legal, governance and enforcement matters

- Implementation and Compliance Committee:
 - Commenting period and further development of guidance and work programme



- Providing further legal clarity:
 - EWG to continue work on review of annexes (IV and related aspects of Annex IX B1110)
 - COP-14 consider extending the mandate of the EWG in order for it to assess the implications of the review of Annexes I, III and IV for other annexes of the Convention

International cooperation and coordination

- Basel Convention Partnership Programme:
 - Follow-up to PACE
 - Household Waste Partnership
 - Further development of partnerships
- Cooperation with WCO:
 - Commenting period on types of waste for which it would be useful to request the WCO to introduce codes in the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System, ranked in order of priority
- OEWG work programme 2020-21

Invitations and registrations

- Early notification: Sent on 25 October 2018
- Invitation letters, agendas and information for participants: End of November 2018
- Registration:
 - Pre-registration, including requests for financial support, with form duly completed and transmitted through official channel (Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the Permanent Mission in Geneva), with a nomination letter / note verbale by 23 January 2019
 - On-site registration
- Funding for one participant per Convention for which an eligible country is Party (i.e. up to 3 participants) for the full two-week duration, pending availability of financial resources



Organization of work

- Bureaux to agree on a tentative schedule of work and on the approach for credentials at their joint meeting on 15-16 November 2018
- Similar approach to 2017 and 2015 being considered:
 - Sequential openings of all three COPs;
 - Joint sessions on joint issues on first day and a half;
 - Convention-specific sessions: SC BC RC;
 - Joint sessions every morning for reports of contact groups;
 - Convention-specific decisions considered during convention-specific sessions;
 - Decisions on joint issues considered for adoption by the 3 COPs in a joint session on 9 May 2019;
 - Conclude with separate sessions for adoption of budgets.
- Limited number of contact groups running in parallel
 - Tentative schedule of possible contact and other groups to be discussed by bureaux at their joint meeting
